



# Everyman's rights

statement #1

# WRONG.

statement #2

**Fishing at some waters is  
okay.**

# RIGHT.

Fishing and ice fishing is allowed to do at some waters.

**statement #3**

**You can pick berries or  
mushrooms.**

# RIGHT.

Yes you can. [ trust me ]

**statement #4**

**You can take dried or fallen  
tree/wood.**



# WRONG.

No you can't. It is against everyman's rights.

statement #5

**Picking lichen ( jäkälää ) is  
allowed.**

# WRONG.

It is not allowed unlike picking berries and mushrooms.

statement #6

**Swimming, boating and  
walking on the ice is allowed.**

# RIGHT.

It isn't against everyman's rights.

**statement #7**

**Sleeping in the nature [ for  
example in forest ], is legal.**

# RIGHT.

**Sleeping in the nature is legal. But remember that some creepy people can be in the nature too.**

statement #8

Driving in the terrain ( maastossa ) with motor vehicle is allowed without asking landowner's permission.



# WRONG.

**It is not allowed by everyman's rights.**

statement #9

**Disturbing environment is  
totally okay.**

# WRONG.

**Disturbing nature/environment is not okay, especially disturbing animals.**

**statement #10**

**Riding horse is allowed to do.**

# RIGHT.

Yes, you can ride horse in the nature without asking permission.
