



# Study Credit Courses – what are they?

- Some courses in Hyvinkään Opisto are marked as study credit courses
  - On these courses it is possible to earn study credits
    - You can participate on these courses also without accumulating study credits
- Study Credit Courses:
  - The objectives and criteria for assessing competence are detailed in the course description
  - The course will be assessed during and/or at the end of the course
  - Courses are graded as pass/fail.
  - The workload per study credit is 27 hours.
  - After completing the course, only passing grades will be entered into the Koski database







# What does a study credit course mean to a student?

As the course begins

- Koski database
  - ✓ All students wishing to be assessed sign a consent form in the beginning of the course.
    - Opisto sends consent forms to all participants by email
      - Those wishing to be assessed sign the form digitally (strong identification with online banking codes)
      - Students without Finnish ID need to sign a paper consent form and prove their identity with official document (passport or ID card)

During the course

- You will show your competence during the course with various assessment methods.
- The teacher will evaluate your competence based on the course assessment criteria.



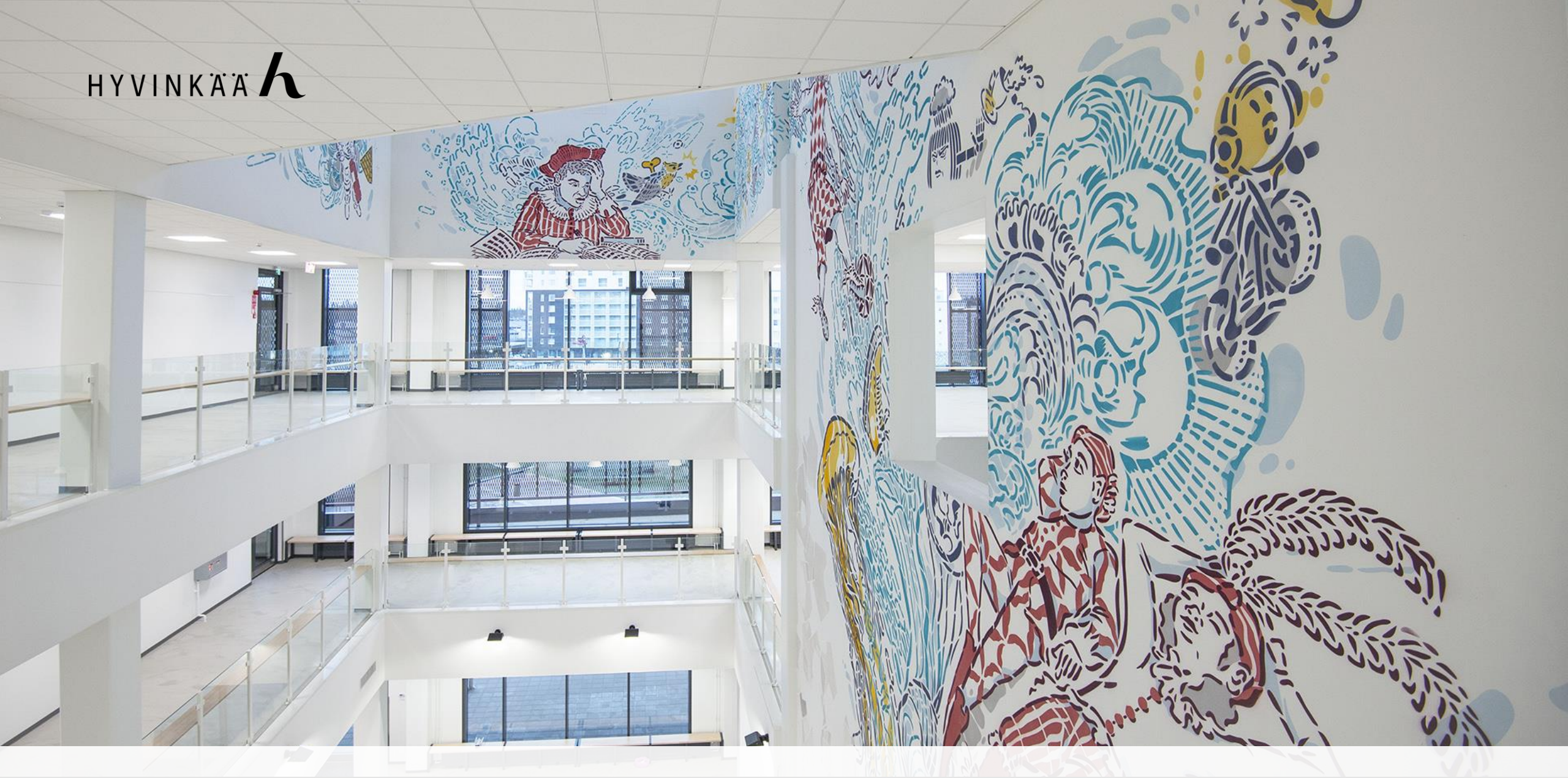
# What does a study credit course mean to a student?

## After the course

- After completing the course, only passing grades will be entered into Koski database
- A diploma is given upon a request (small fee is charged for the diploma)

NB! You can withdraw your consent for information transfer to Koski database at any given time.
