Material	German ActLib exercise 1 Ballad <i>Herr Ribbeck von Ribbeck von Havelland</i> Papers (size A3) Pencils and coloured pencils
Process	<ol> <li>Teacher hands out pupils the ballad in German by Theodor Fontane.</li> <li>Teacher explains what the poem is about in pupils' first language.</li> <li>The recording or the rap version of the poem is listened to.</li> <li>Pupils plan a work of art in which they use some text of the ballad. The text can, for example, be a part of the picture or outlines of the patterns.</li> <li>Pupils copy some text of the poem in their work of art.</li> </ol>
Duration	2 x 45 minutes
Expected learning results	Pupil learns to use words and text in a work of art. Pupil gets to know a poem in German.
