Faith heals?

When patients hear they are getting pain relief, for instance, their confidence 4 the pain vanishing soon causes an increase 5 the release of the neurotransmitter dopamine in the brain. Research 6 the placebo effect even suggests that many drugs may only be boosters to the placebo effect. However, there is no shortage 7 problems with harnessing placebos for mainstream use. If we accept that many drugs mostly work on sham, then will we lose faith 8 medicine? Our expectations will plunge, and with them the placebo effect.
