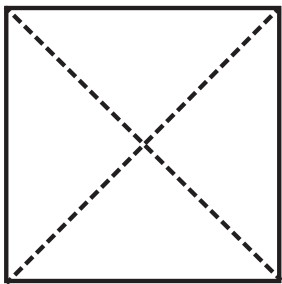




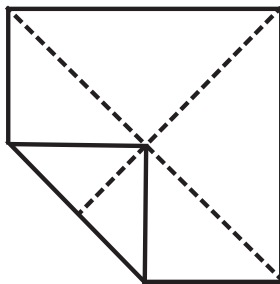
Cut out along the dashed line.

# Instructions

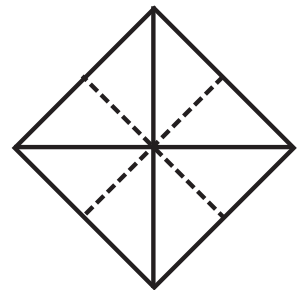
With the artwork facing down, fold each corner to the opposite corner and unfold. You should have creases in your paper like this.



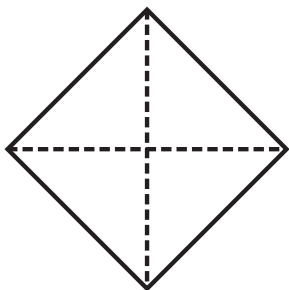
Fold all the corners to the center of the paper. Be sure to press the creases well!



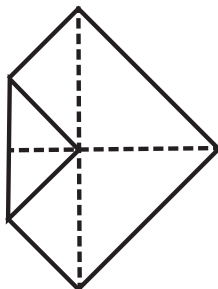
Now your paper should look like this.



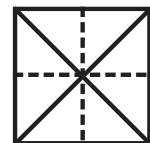
Turn your paper over so the folds you just made are facing down.



As before, fold all the corners to the center.



Now your paper should look like this.



Now fold your paper in half, and then fold in half again. Press the creases well!



From one square, open back to two squares. Insert your fingers under the tabs and fold in.
