Morning Rehearsals and Meetings

All choirs will rehearse together each morning (July 13-18) under the direction of Festival Chorus Directors. Youth choirs and Children's choirs will sometimes rehearse separately, and sometimes together. Choirs may use their music for rehearsal, but they will be expected to perform the combined music memorized for the Closing Ceremony.

Your singers should be prepared to sing all combined repertoire:

Each morning there will be a daily meeting led by Lisa D'Annunzio, Festival Manager, which will cover important Festival information for the day and remainder of the week. All adult Festival chaperones that are not attending the rehearsals with their choirs should be present and should convey the information to those who are not able to be present. Conductors are encouraged to attend the morning meetings if they choose not to attend the Combined Festival Choirs rehearsals. The morning meeting will take place in the Festival Hospitality Room.

Festival Check-In

Festival check-in will take place at the Opening Reception on Sunday, July 12, 2015.

Concerts

The *Opening Ceremonies* on Monday, July 13 will begin at 7:00pm at the Scottish Rite Center in Oakland. All choirs must arrive at Scottish Rite Center by 6:00pm, dressed in their concert uniform. Choirs will be allotted a 15-minute sound check between 12:15pm and

5:00pm to prepare for the concert. During the concert, each choir will be introduced and then perform one piece. Choirs will then be seated in the audience to enjoy the rest of the program.

Competition Concerts. Competition concerts take place on July 14, 15, and 17. Date assignments can be found in your individual schedules. Please note that any sound check assignments and specific concert order will not be ready until June.

Spotlight Concerts. On Tuesday and Wednesday nights at 7:00pm, choirs will share an additional, non-adjudicated *Spotlight Concert* with 2-3 other choirs. Each choir will sing a 25-minute set of music. An acoustic baby grand piano will be available. **Singers arrive to these venues dressed in their concert uniforms or costumes**. Spotlight Concert assignments were sent on April 8, but they are also included in each choir's individual schedule.

The *Closing Ceremony* is on Saturday, July 18, at 7:00pm at the Scottish Rite Center in Oakland. All singers will perform the combined repertoire. Competition winners will be asked to perform 1 or 2 pieces.

Social Events

Opening Reception – All paid adult participants are invited to meet each other and Festival staff at the home of Andrea and Paul Swenson, Festival sponsors, on Sunday, July 12, from 5:00pm – 7:00pm. Please see included document for more information.

Welcome Picnic – The Welcome Picnic will take place on Monday, July 13, from 12:15pm-4:00pm at the Lake Merritt Amphitheater. Please see included document for more information.

Bay Cruise – Thursday, July 16, 2:00pm – 5:00pm. Participants will travel via Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) from the Scottish Rite Center to San Francisco after a shortened morning rehearsal. Choirs will be escorted by Festival volunteers and will be provided with BART tickets.

Conductors' Banquet – Friday, July 17, 6:00pm-9:00pm. Each choir's conductor and a guest are invited to attend the conductors' banquet. If you are traveling with two choirs (Cantabella, Young People's, and Kinder-&-Jugendsingakademie), you will receive 2 tickets per choir, so 4 tickets total. If you do NOT need all 4 tickets, please let us know. If you would like to bring additional guests, a per-person fee of \$85 is required.
