- Population (12/2013) 17 678
- Municipal budget 120 M €
- Municipal tax rate (2014) 20,00 %
- the economical, commercial and cultural centre of the region (South-Western Häme, total population 36 000)
- Main businesses are in the fields of food manufacturing, electronics, environmental and information technology

# Art School for Children and Young People - since 1984 -

Basic education in visual arts for children from age of four years up to young people of age 18. Goal-oriented and progressing education from one level to other. Teaches children skills in self-expression and capabilities needed for vocational, polytechnic and university education. Receives government grants.

- Early childhood education (63 hours per year, 1-3 years)
- Basic studies (63-93 hours per year, 2-6 years)

## Music School of South-Western Häme - since 1964-

Basic education in music for children from age of four years up to young people of age 18. Goal-oriented and progressing education from one level to other. Teaches children skills in self-expression and capabilities needed for vocational, polytechnic and university education. Receives yearly government grant.

- Early childhood education (lesson once per week, 2-3 years)
- Basic studies (several modules, 500 hours of study)
- Specialisation studies (with basic studies accumulate to 1300 lessons of study)

**Instruments** piano, organ, accordion, guitar, Finnish zither, violin, cello, clarinet, trumpet, drums, bass, singing etc.

#### Adult Institute - since 1920 -

Educational establisment that welcomes all prospective adult learners and offer opportunities for wide variety of recreational activities and study. Learning is largely self-motivated and, as a rule, not aimed at achieving a formal qualification. Receives government grants based on the confirmed number of lesson hours given.

In Forssa, gives also basic education of art (theatre, crafts) for children. Provides also Finnish as a foreign language tuition for immigrants.



### Forssa Museum - reopened in November 2013 -

Municipal service since the year 2010. State funding of 50 000 € per year.

**Opening hours** Forssa Museum: tue-thur 12-18, fri-sun 12-16

Textile Museum Tyyki: closed till june 2014

Ronttismäki Factory Worker's Museum:

open in summertime only.

New exhibition 'Town of Tinted Textiles' in former cotton storage building (1849).

The Forssa Museum moved in this building in 1980.

The lobby of the Museum is a gallery of temporary exhibitions.

Collections include ca. 25 000 objects, more than 105 000 photographs, and dozens of archives of associations, companies and private people.

Forssa Textile archive is the specialty of the museum, telling about the 162-year-history of the Forssa cotton industry.

Shop in museum, many projects to improve and create new services for the community, cooperation with tourism personnel, many kinds of events etc.

Market in Spinning Mill Area in summer and Xmas [7-8].

Saturday in Spinning Mill Area for Families once per month [7-8].

Celebration of Veteran day 27.4., Labour Day 1.5.,

Independance Day 6.12. and New Year 31.12.

**Concerts** Tyykijazz, Forssa Unplugged, Choir concerts,

Xmas concert and others [10-15].

Forssa Week once every year.

**Art Häme –event** is organized every fourth year by Forssa.





# **Cooperation across municipal boundaries**

**Louna-libraries,** Library cooperation of municipal libraries of Forssa, Humppila, Jokioinen, Tammela and Ypäjä since 1985: common ADP-system and OPAC, common rules for customers, common acquition of library material, transportation of library material in the area, common events and marketing, common projects with state grants...

**Adult Institute** provides services also for Tammela based on an agreement. Administration services is sold to the adult institute of Jokioinen, Humppila and Ypäjä (Jokiläänin kansalaisopisto.)

**Art School** and **Music School** provide services also in the nabouring municipalities (official agreements). Education is organized mainly in the premises in Spinning Mill Area of Forssa.

**Art exhibitions** every now and then may circle round the region.



**Employees of municipalities** have meetings together.

**Education programmes** for employees of all five municipalities.
