- Learning concept constructed for Peda.net platform
- Combining the ideas of blended learning, flexi-study and PLE:
- Supporting learning by various digital resources (online material, videos, and other e-media)
- Using PLE (personal learning environment) as an e-portfolio for professional growth and education of teachers and teacher students.
- PLE in Peda.net is an electronic format for students to record their work, goals, and achievements, reflect their learning, share their learning and receive feedback and feedforward. (<a href="www.elearning.tki.org.nz">www.elearning.tki.org.nz</a>)
- Based on collaborative learning, which exists in various levels/communities at the same time: among students of a course, among previous and contemporary students of the same courses, and in the schools of the teachers in in-service education
- The pilot case of ours: enlargen the possibilities of Peda.net in the study of mother tongue and literature. According our vision the ideology of PLE will permeate through the teacher studies and in-service education in JYU.

## How do we learn in MorePeda?

- Contact sessions, regional groups, with peers in the education (both in- and pre-service teachers) and/or collegues at school
- In contact (demos, regional small groups), in the platform
- Making learning material and testing it, reflecting the usefulness of the material and acting as a teacher, co-working with peers (videos, presentations, discussions, argumentation)
- Modelling the teaching practices of one's own
- Collecting the useful data concerning teaching and individual learning in the PLE of student's own
