Herbert W. Marsh is an educational psychologist who has published influential research on self-concept, motivation and university students' evaluations of teaching effectiveness. He has been recognised as the most productive educational psychologist in the world. From 2006–2011 he was Professor of Education at Oxford University where he holds an Emeritus Professorship. He coined the phrase 'substantive-methodological research synergy', which underpins his substantive and methodological research interests. He is the founder of the International SELF Research Centre.
