

131. Ta unë kyö' ö ne hêwötë' shä' ne' hu wae' héôwe thanyushút ne hunu' së ta unë ti ne hakëh'tsi waë' "Niyu.

132. Únë nae tēkōsnye' ēkōya' tahsēnōni' khu." tēkōsnye' - I' ll take care of you. ēkōya' tahsēnōni' - I' ll dress you up, "put your body away."

138. Tá ne' tih kyö' ö utiiwanëëkwa' ö. utiiwanëëkwa' ö - they were surprised.

139. Tyëëkwa únë kyö' ö aayê' khô wááku' ne' ne wauhikwääku' hunö' ëë' ke kakwékö nae ne usta' shô. Tyëëkwa - suddenly. aayê' - it seems. wááku' - he took. ne wauhikwääku' - he uncapped, uncovered his head. hunö' ëë' ke - his head. kakwékö - all. usta' - scab, scale.
