The Municipality of litti

- litti has founded in 1870, the old parish in 1539.
 - o litti is a part of the North Kymi Region in southeastern Finland.
 - The River Kymi and forests and hills dotted multiple lakes are typical scenery in Northern litti, so called "Veskansa" about "Waterfolk".
 - Large Fields and open views with sparcely situated rock consist Landscape on Southern litti, so called "Maakansa" about "Landfolk".
 - o In litti lives about 7400 residents and more than 2000 holiday residents.



- **Kausala** is the administrative centre of litti, population is about 3000 persons.
 - Kausala is old railway station village since late 1800s, nowadays it is a active commercial centre
 - Several shops and services to offer
 - Business and industry: companies working with air-condition, woodprosessing, plastics, electronic and blacksmithing



- litti Church Village was old centre of life in litti
 - o litti Lutheran Church from the 1600s
 - Local History Museum in old parish granary
 - The village environment with old Empire-style village school, now Village Café
