

# The Municipality of Iitti

- **Iitti** has founded in 1870, the old parish in 1539.
  - Iitti is a part of the North Kymi Region in southeastern Finland.
  - The River Kymi and forests and hills dotted multiple lakes are typical scenery in Northern Iitti, so called “Veskansa” about “Waterfolk”.
  - Large Fields and open views with sparsely situated rock consist Landscape on Southern Iitti, so called “Maakansa” about “Landfolk”.
  - In Iitti lives about 7400 residents and more than 2000 holiday residents.



- **Kausala** is the administrative centre of Iitti, population is about 3000 persons.
  - Kausala is old railway station village since late 1800s, nowadays it is a active commercial centre
  - Several shops and services to offer
  - Business and industry : companies working with air-condition, wood-processing, plastics, electronic and blacksmithing



- **Iitti Church Village** was old centre of life in Iitti
  - Iitti Lutheran Church from the 1600s
  - Local History Museum in old parish granary
  - The village environment with old Empire-style village school, now Village Café
