

Brief information for guardians of new first graders, 19 May 2026

1. School Pedanet website: [Pedanet Ivalon koulu](#)
2. Wilma system. Wilma is the school's official communication channel. Login instructions and credentials will be sent in June to the email address provided by the guardian. It is recommended to activate the account by early August at the latest, so that you will receive up-to-date information before the school starts.
3. On the way to school. It is advisable to practise the school route in advance. School transport is provided when the distance to school exceeds three (3) kilometres. Instructions regarding school transport will be released once the schedules are finalized in early August. Bus timetables will be available in Wilma and Pedanet. Office secretary Marika Jalonen will provide additional information if needed, tel. +358 40 168 5574 or email marika.jalonen@inari.fi. If a child is brought to or picked up from school by car, the drop-off/pick-up area is in the loop area on the left side of the bus lane. Map available at school peda.net site. The daycare parking area is reserved for the daycare unit only.
4. First grade includes 21 hours of instruction per week.
5. Guardians must inform the teacher of any health-related information that should be taken into account at school. Special diets are arranged through the school nurse. Health check-ups for new pupils have already started or will begin soon.
6. If a child receives occupational or speech therapy, it is advisable to discuss this with the teacher.
7. Absences. The teacher must be informed of absences due to illness. The teacher may grant leave from school for other reasons for 1–3 days. Leave exceeding three days must be applied for (from the vice principal).
8. Afternoon activities. Children can participate in the school's after-school activities after the school day until 4:30 pm. The application form is available on the school's Pedanet website.
