

# Pecha Kucha

A model of presenting information developed in Japan by business leaders which limits the time available to the presenter. It therefore ensures that only the most relevant information is included.

A Pecha Kucha presentation lasts for only 6 minutes and 40 seconds. It is very strictly limited to a maximum of 20 images - no key words.



Images can include words of course, as long as they are part of the image.

The script should describe the image or discuss idea/point being made in relation to it.

Now comes the tricky part, the image **must** change every 20 seconds.



Twenty slides each lasting 20 seconds equals 6 minutes and 40 seconds.

**Can you do it?**
