Introduction

This Tolerance Book brings together visible student works and classroom products prepared during the ECHOES project. The selected works are connected with tolerance, respect, empathy, cultural diversity, inclusion and living together.

Student Work 1: Artwork on Peaceful Living Together

Type	Artwork
Theme	tolerance, respect, cultural diversity

This student artwork presents peaceful living together through visual symbols of connection, nature and shared space. It links tolerance with friendship, kindness and respect for differences.

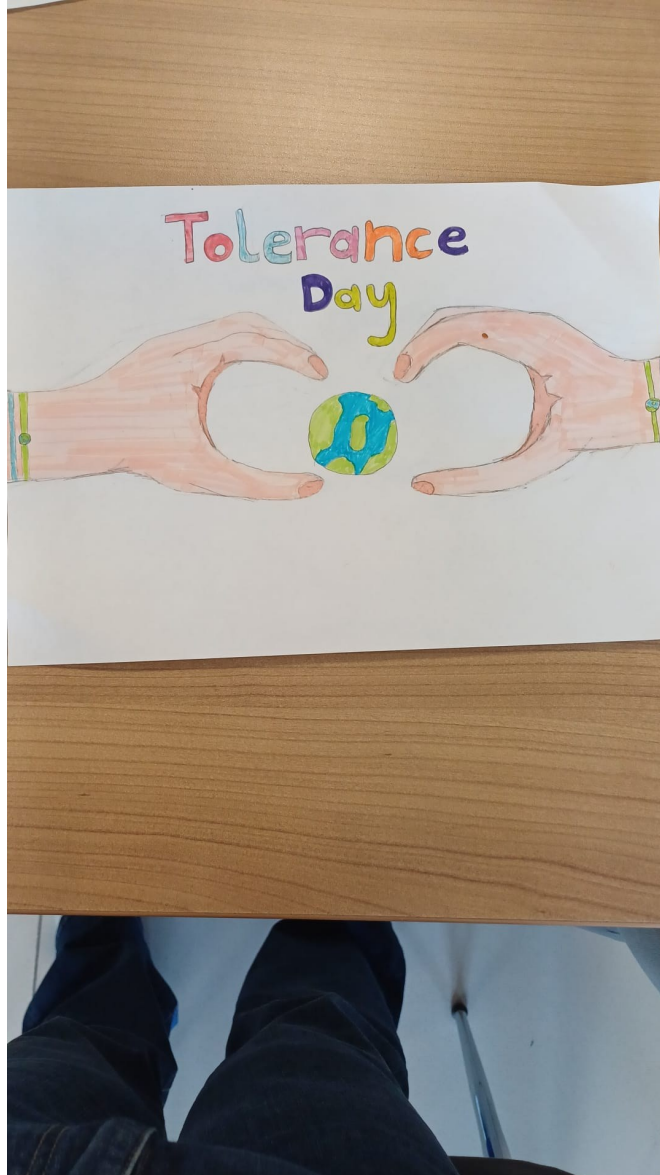


Student artwork on peaceful living together.

Student Work 2: Tolerance Day Drawing

Type	Artwork
Theme	unity, peace, shared world

This drawing presents Tolerance Day through hands, a heart shape and the Earth. It reminds students that different people share the same world and need to live with care and respect.

This drawing connects peace with hope and harmony. The image of the Earth, a bird and peaceful symbols shows tolerance as a value that belongs to everyday life and to the wider world.

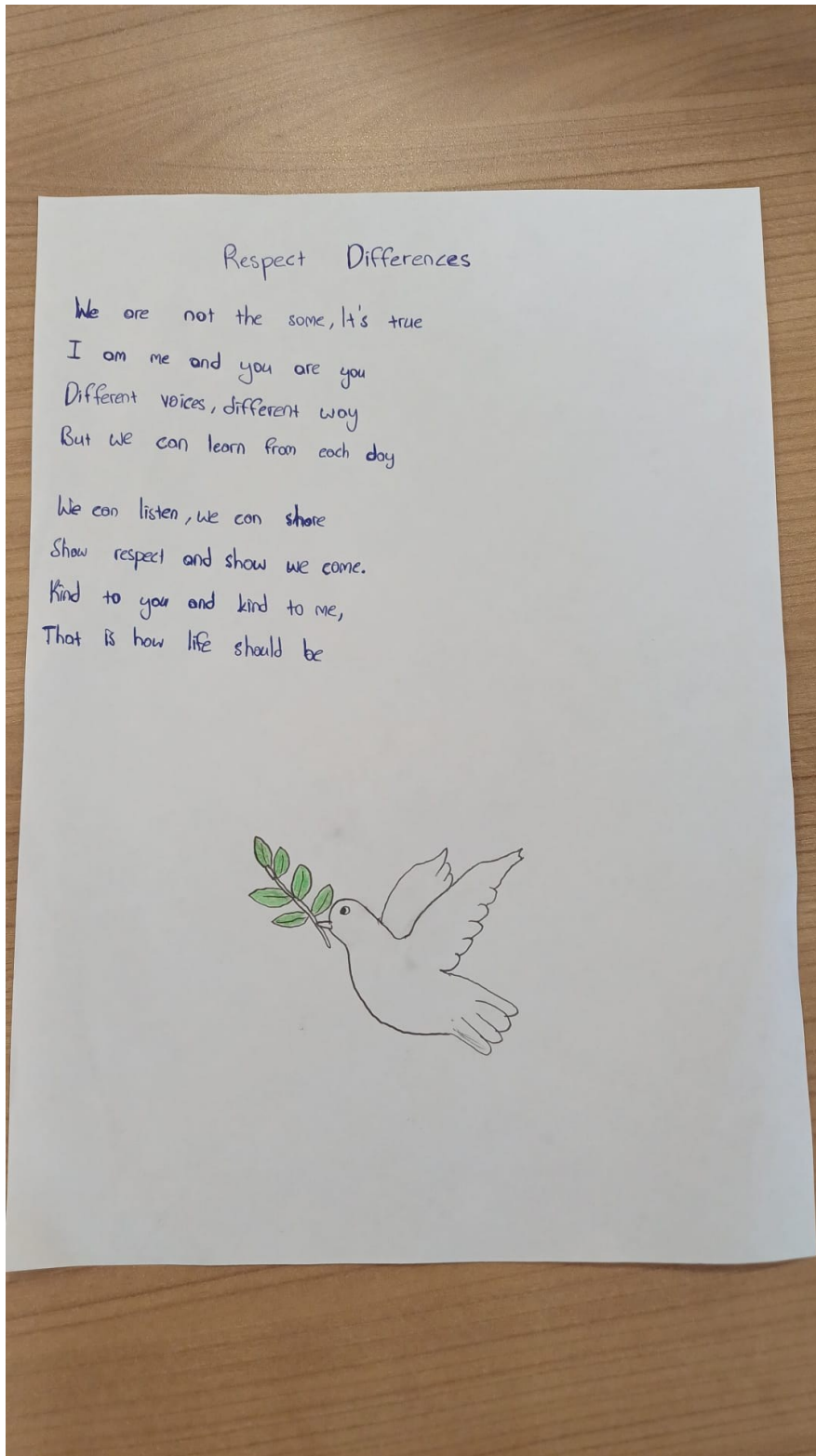

Student Work 5: Poem on Language Diversity

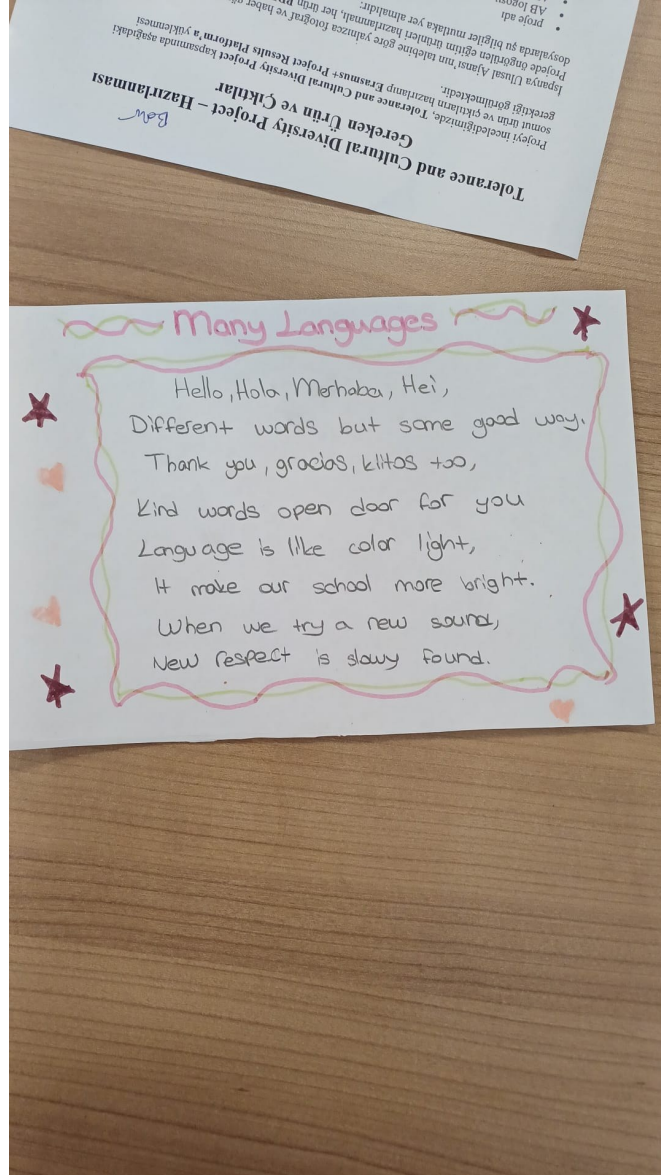

This student poem is about language diversity. It suggests that learning words, stories and expressions from other cultures can help students understand and respect one another.



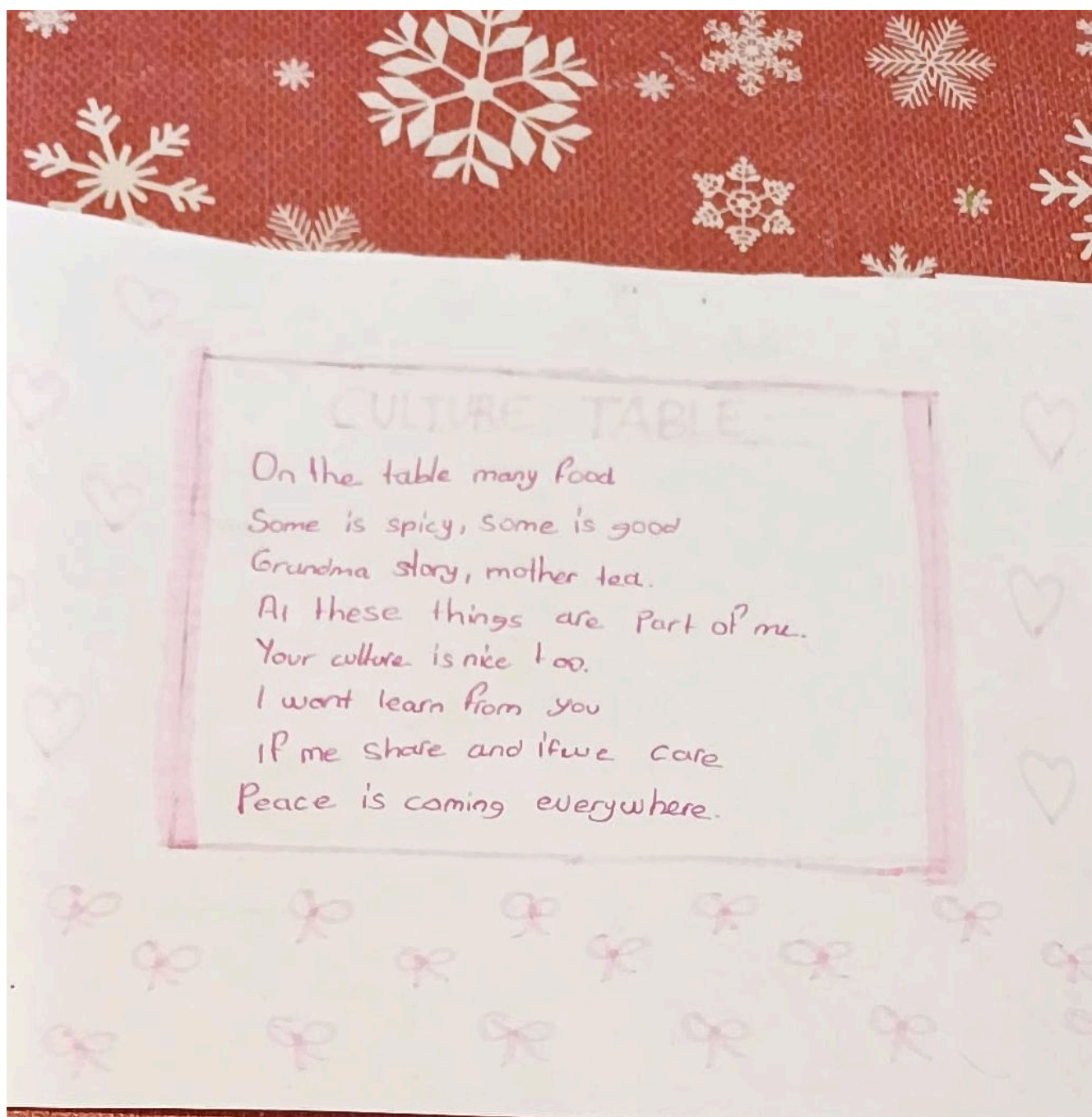

Student Work 6: Poems and Reflections on Sharing and Togetherness

Type	Poems / student reflections
Theme	sharing, friendship, school identity

This group brings together student texts about sharing, culture, daily tolerance and school identity. The texts connect tolerance with simple classroom actions such as listening, welcoming others, sharing stories and respecting different ways of life.

Included entries: Sharing and Togetherness Poem, Culture Table Poem, Daily Tolerance Poem and Together Wall Poem.

Students prepared logo and slogan designs connected with the project theme. The works use flags, hands, the Earth, hearts and project symbols to represent common values, cooperation and unity across partner countries.

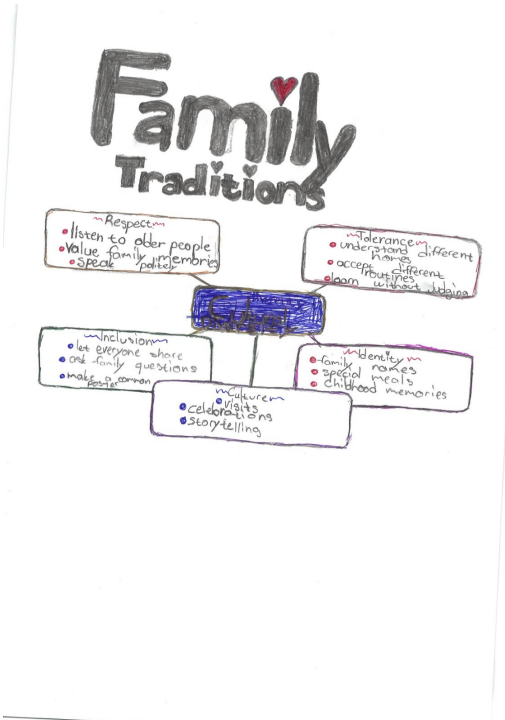

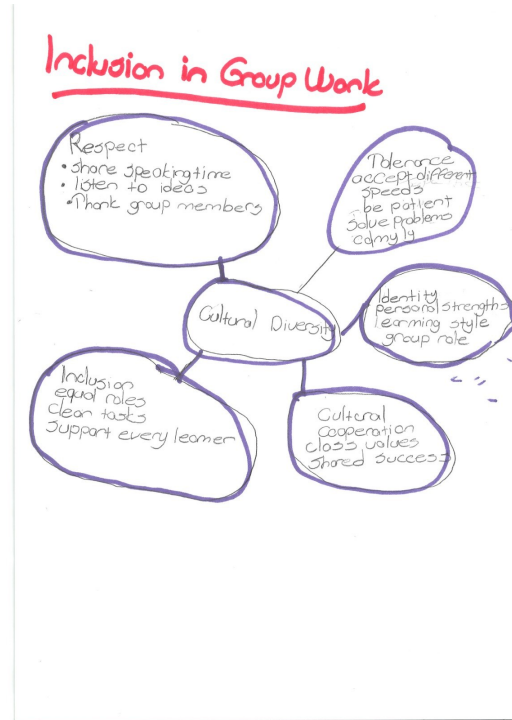
Student Work 8: Cultural Diversity Concept Maps

Theme	culture, language, family, respect

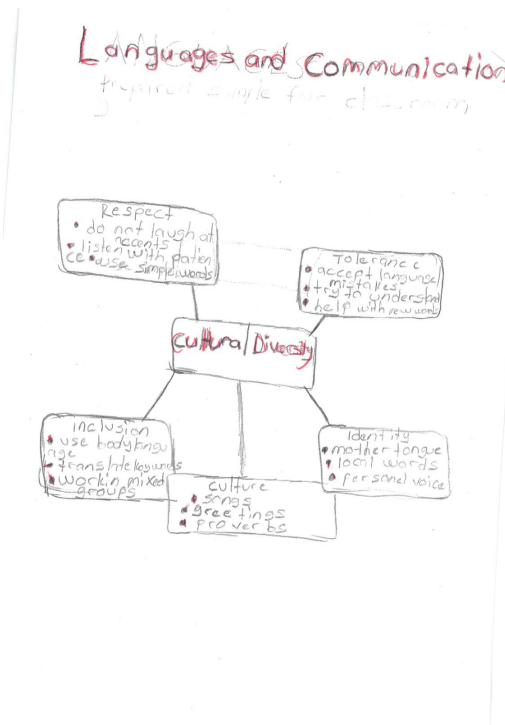
Students created concept maps to explore cultural diversity through daily life themes such as family traditions, inclusion, language, music, dance and respectful classroom behavior. The maps helped students organize ideas visually and connect culture with respect.



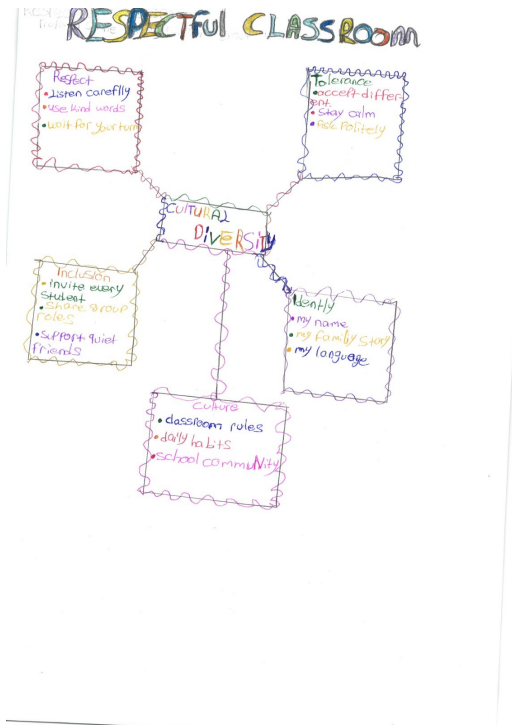
Concept map about family traditions.

Theme	diversity, visibility, shared values

Type	Theater / role play
Theme	inclusion, empathy, school life

Students used drama and performance to work on empathy, inclusion and different points of view. These activities helped them understand how a person can feel excluded and how a group can change the situation through kindness and shared responsibility.

Type	Game / group activity
Theme	cooperation, balance, respect

This game used a simple balance task to open a discussion about cooperation. Students and teachers worked together, listened to different ideas and observed how a group needs patience and respect to keep a shared structure stable.

Theme	teamwork, empathy, communication

Arts and crafts activities gave students a practical way to express tolerance. Students worked with materials, colors and shapes while sharing ideas and supporting each other. The heart shaped works show unity without making everyone the same.

Students explored examples of people, stories and cultural references connected with positive values. These activities helped students move from abstract ideas such as peace and respect to concrete examples, stories and figures.



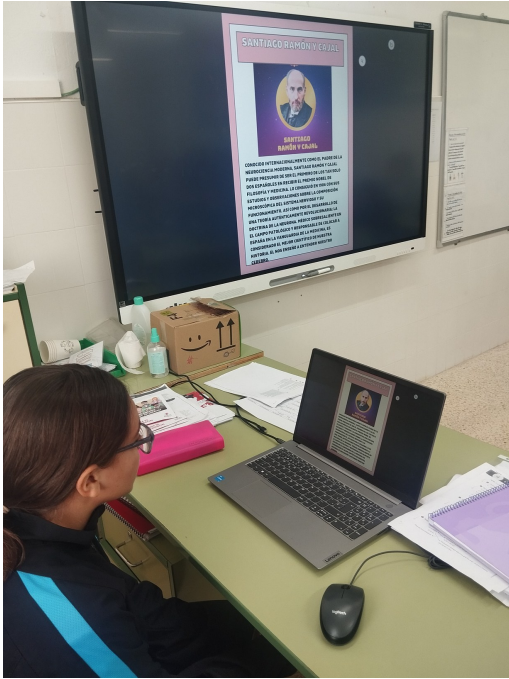
