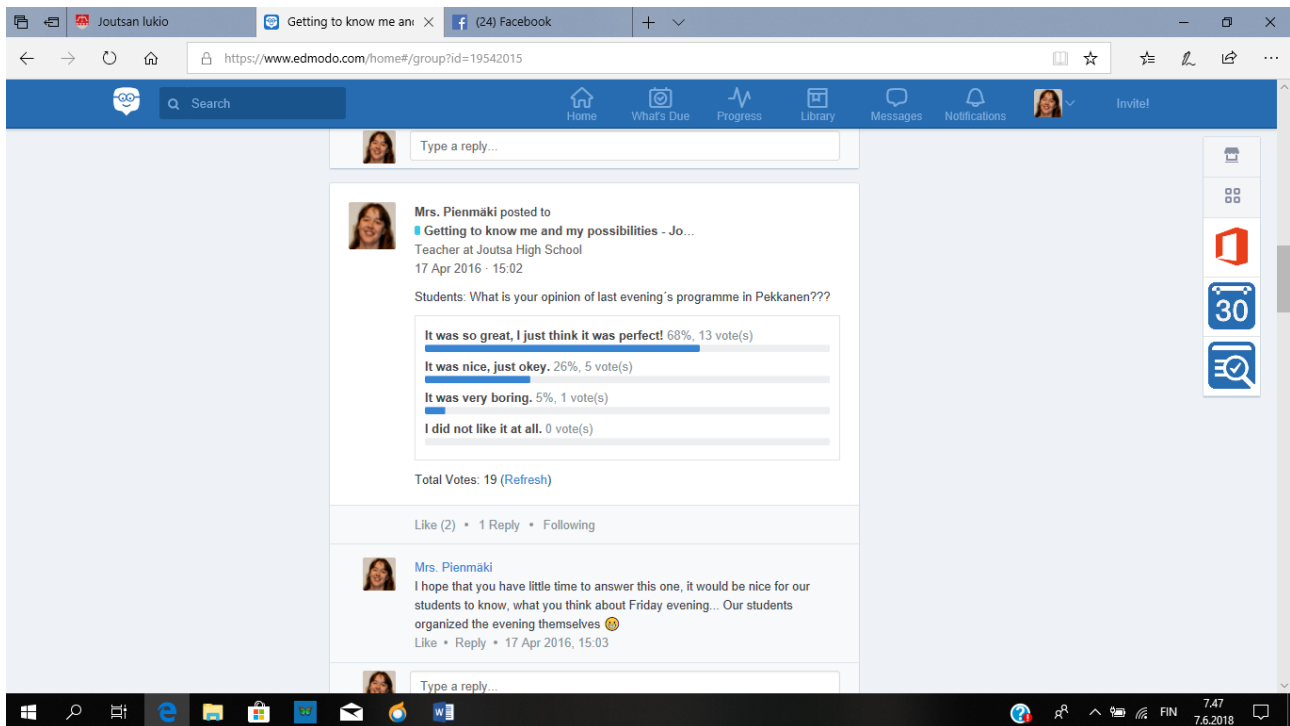
### ICT –methods and skills

The use of ICT apps was increased during the project. We had the same methods all the time, as Edmodo, whatsapp for teachers, homepage, emails and we took new methods as the project developed.

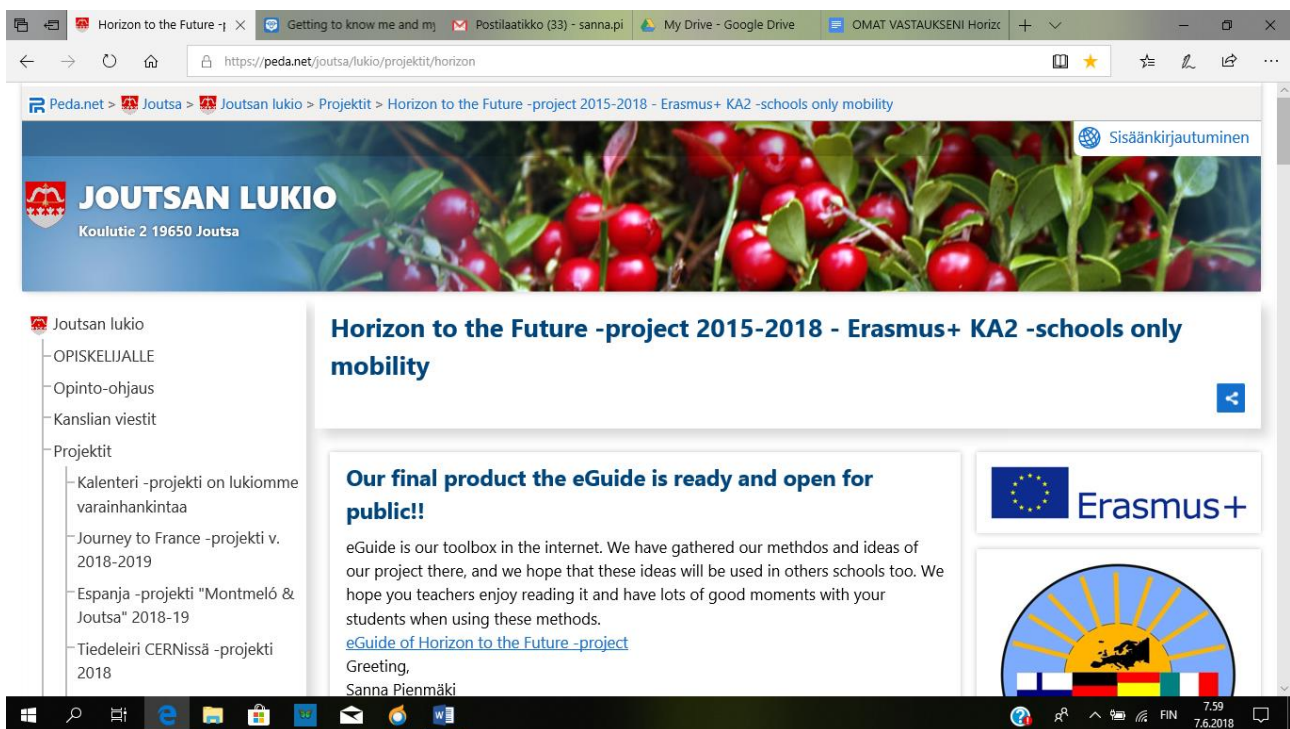
The first year of the project we first used mainly emails. In Autumn -15 we opened a Whatsapp group for teachers (now 28 members) and began to learn how to use [edmodo.com](http://edmodo.com). In Edmodo we had a site for each workshop and one teachers' group, which folders are like a "library" for us in order to file all our documents. Cambre team had their blog from the beginning and so did Finnish students, one blog from each workshop. Official homepage was opened. In Joutsa we tried to have a skype meeting with 50 participants, we did not try that again. Joutsa students began #horizoncrew in Instagram during Montmelo workshop, and as coordinator joined Instagram in February 2016 the use of that increased.

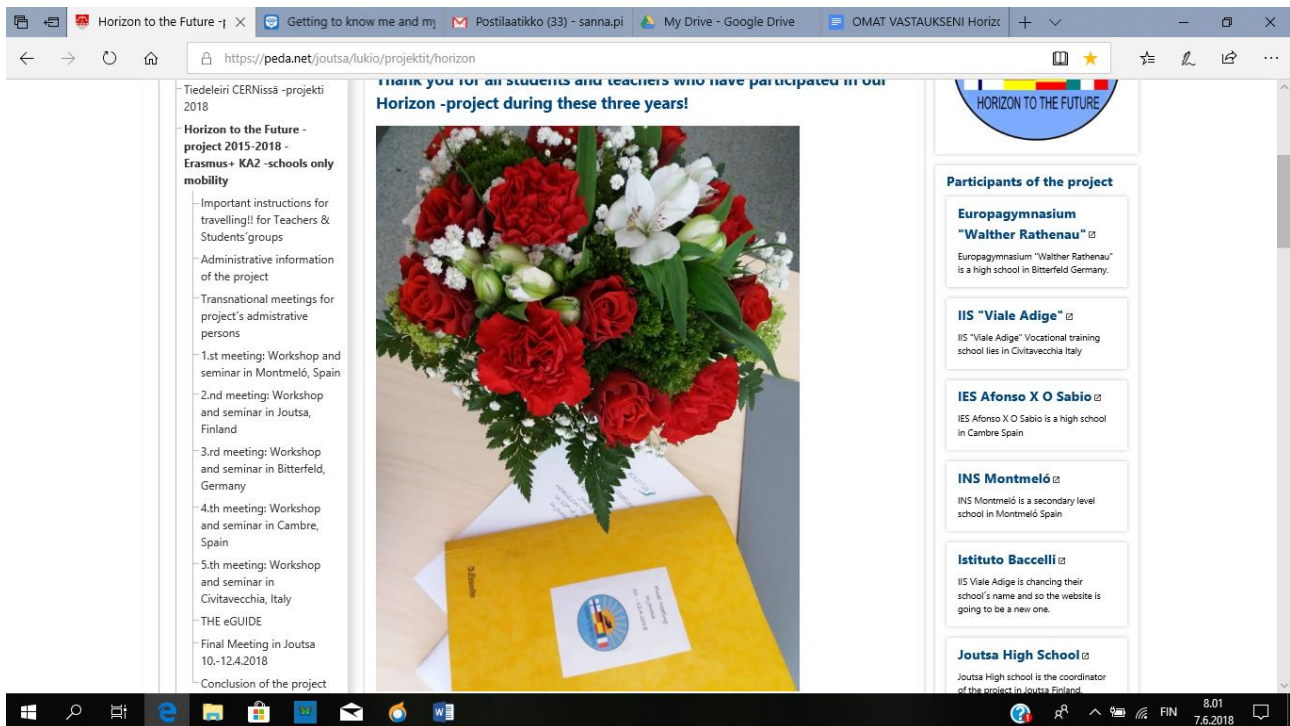

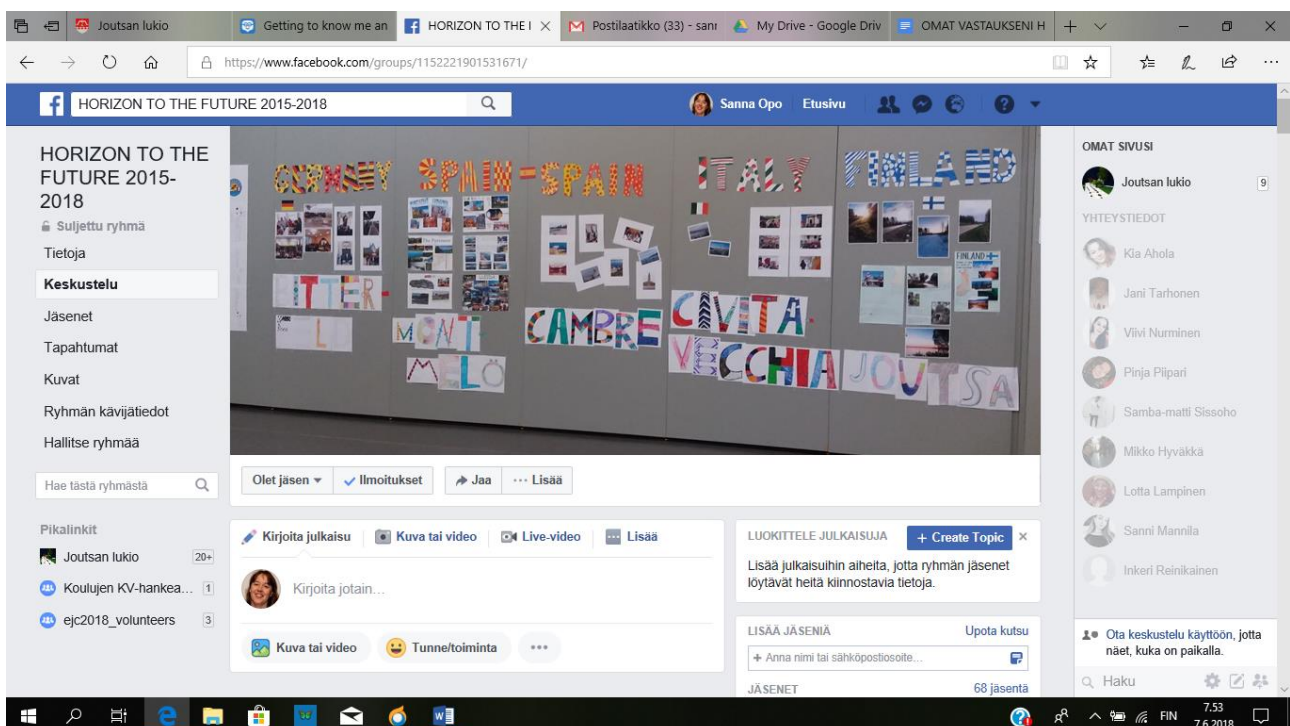

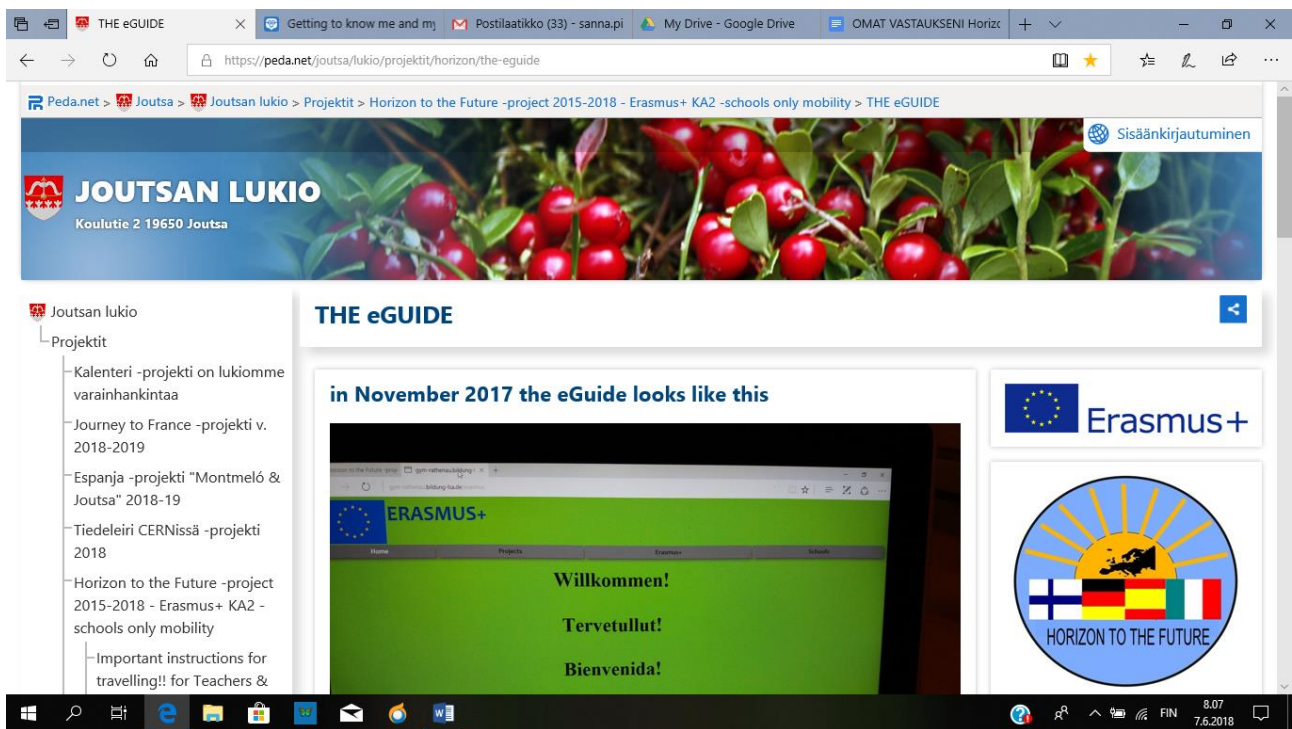

German team began to develop our eGuide in it's own site with the help of their students, their school agreed to be eGuide's administrator in the future.

In Facebook we have a closed group for alumni work:

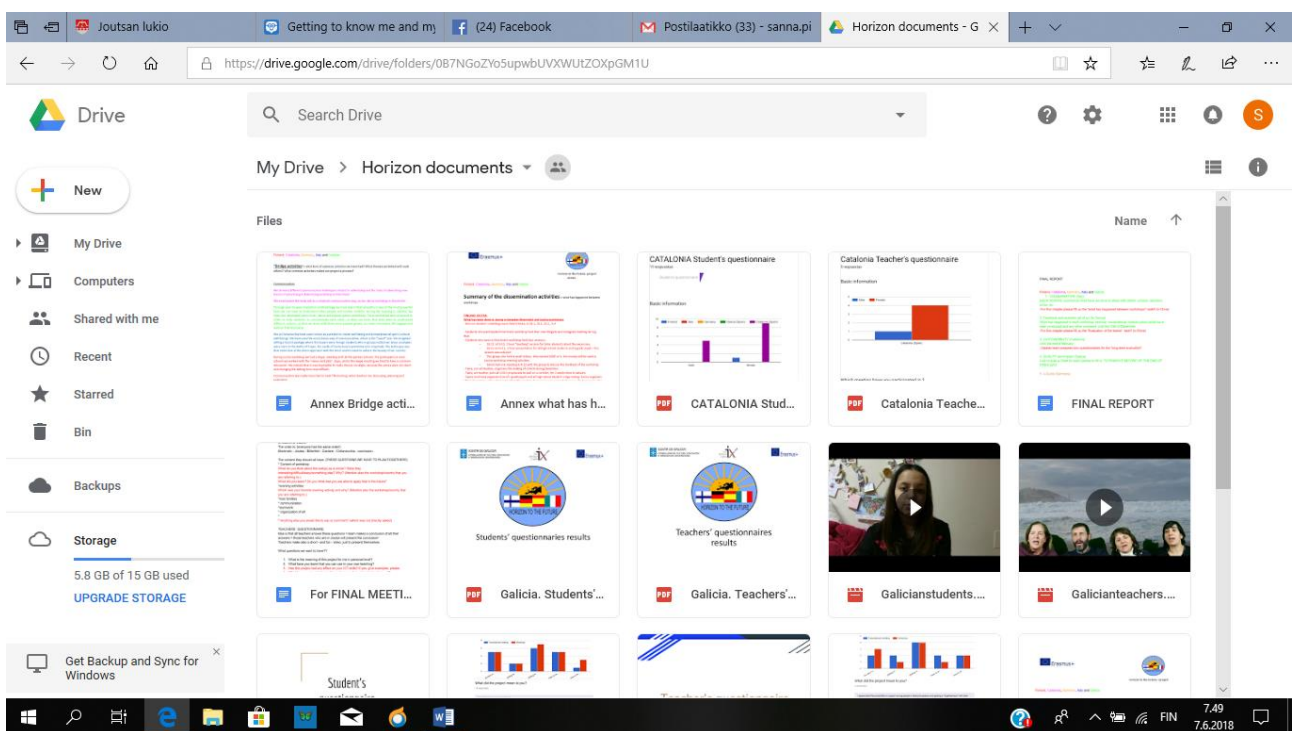


eGuide has it's own homepage where it's development has been documented.
