








Which meeting have you participated in?




What did the project mean to you?

- ❖ It was an amazing experience, since I met new friends and visited a place that I might never have visited.


What did the project mean to you?

- A unique opportunity to interact with people from other cultures and share time in common, in addition to a great experience to practice English and at the same time know new countries.


Which specific e-learnings have you acquired due to TN meetings or workshops that you attended?




Are you keeping in touch with any of the colleagues from the other countries/ regions?



With which countries?




By which mean?




Rate the project in general.

(1 low 2 medium 3 good 4 very good)




Grade your English level improvement. (1 low 2 medium 3 high 4 very high)



52,4% answers were positive or better: OK


After this experience, do you feel closer to European countries?

Grade your English level improvement.



After this experience, do you feel closer to European countries?



Grade your improvement in social skills thanks to the project participation




How were you welcomed by the host family or hotel staff, roommates, local teachers, etc.



Have you acquired any skills for working in international educational programmes after this experience? (1 not 2 some 3 quite 4 a lot)


