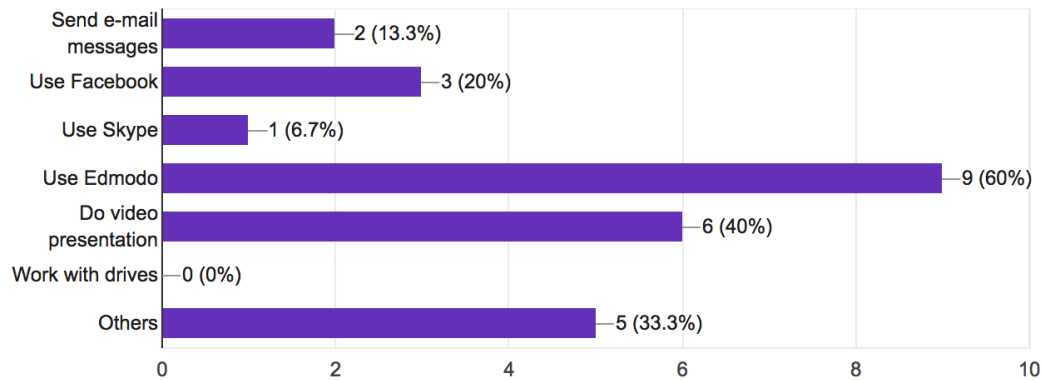

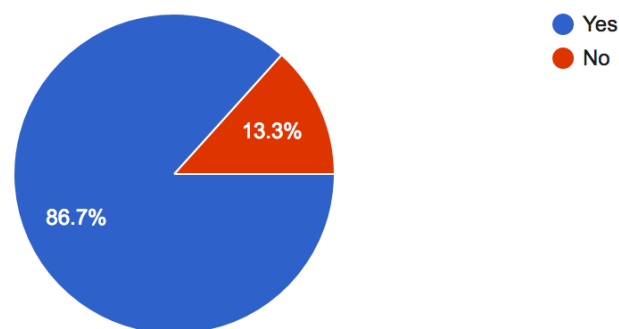

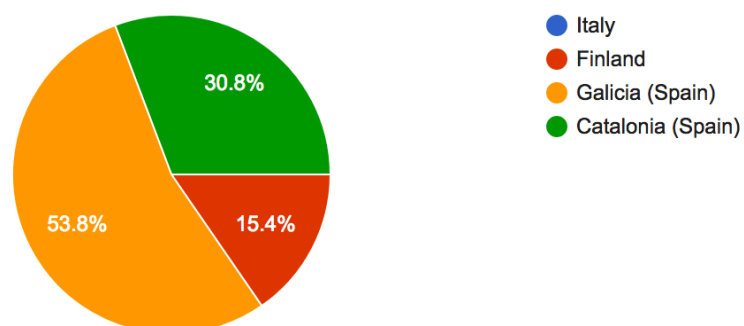

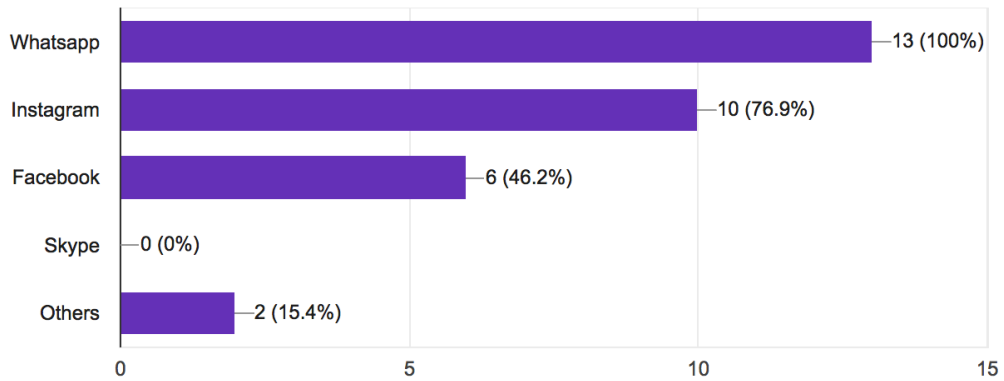
## If yes, from which countries?

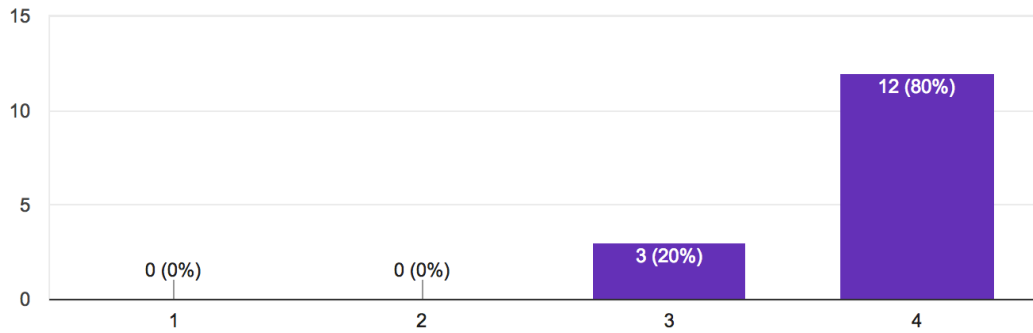

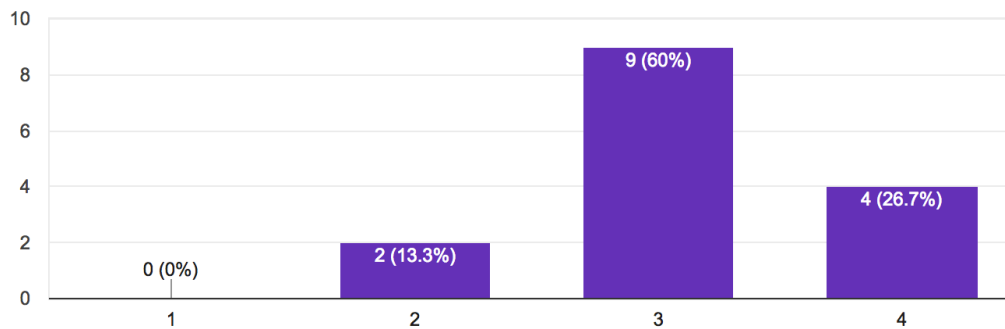

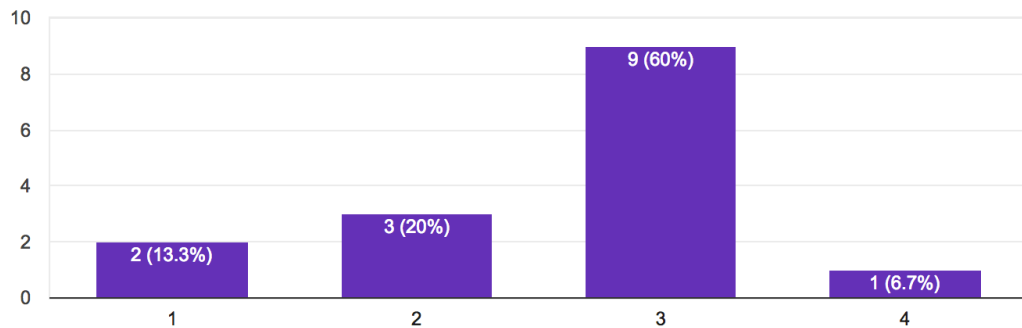

Grade your English level improvement. ( 1 low 2 medium 3 high 4 very high)



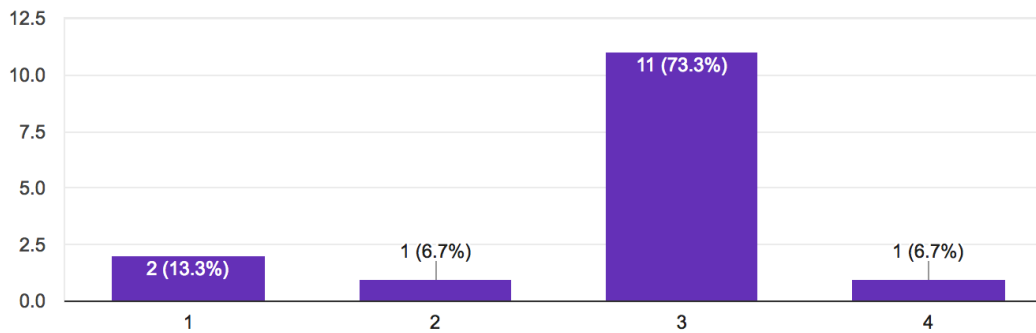

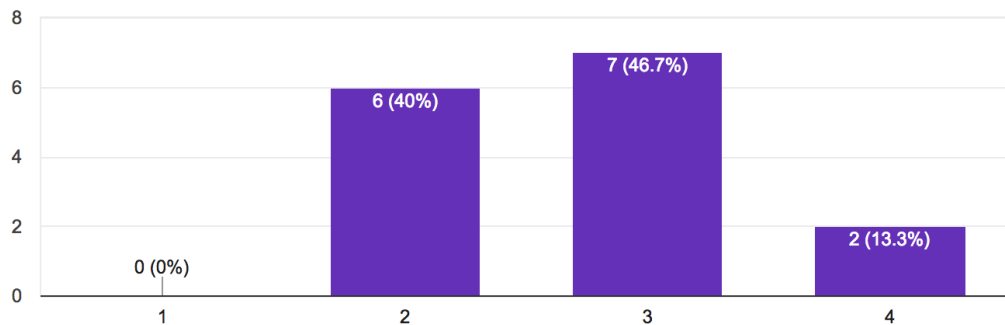

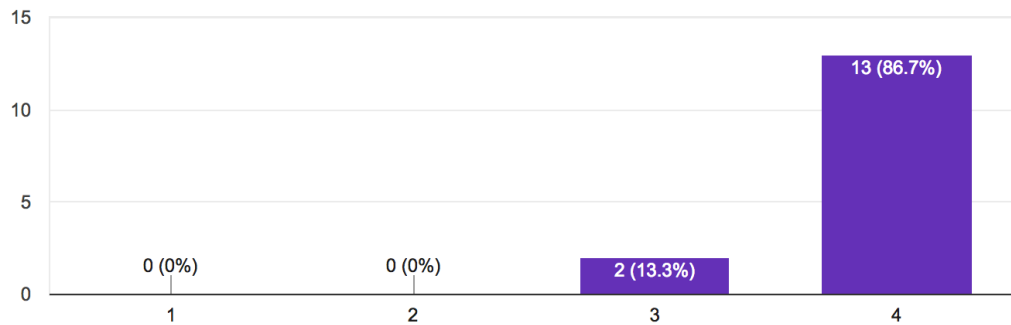

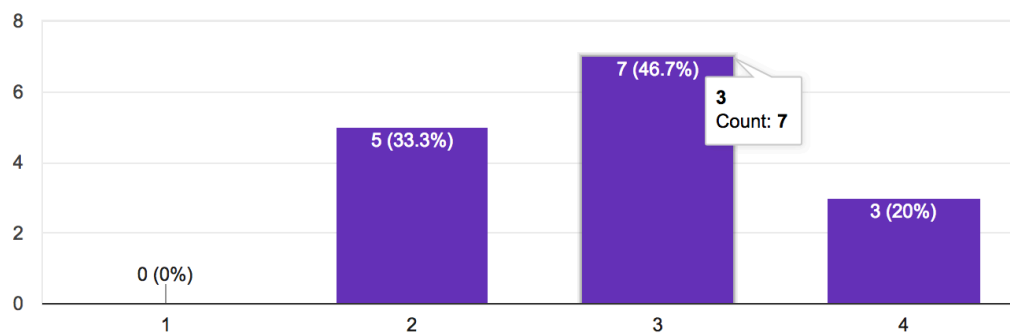

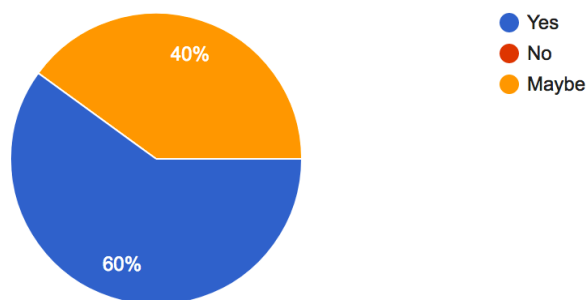

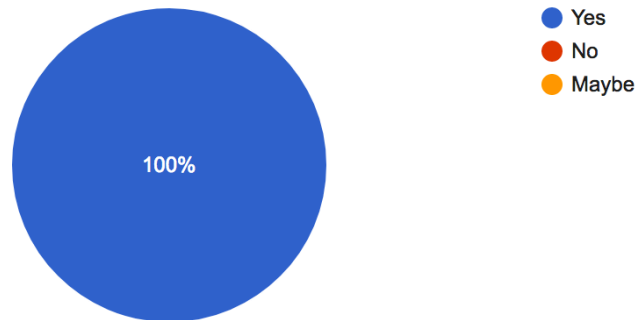
