- 1 In principle, indigenous education cannot be faulted and should be a part of all educational systems.
- 2 It is understandable that, when they achieved freedom from the colonial powers, most African countries chose to indigenize or Africanize their education systems.
- 3 In hindsight, the rigorous emphasis on and pursuit of indigenous education in Africa after freedom from colonialism, was not unproblematic and may even have disadvantaged the people and the countries in some ways.
