(Leshan Giant Buddha)



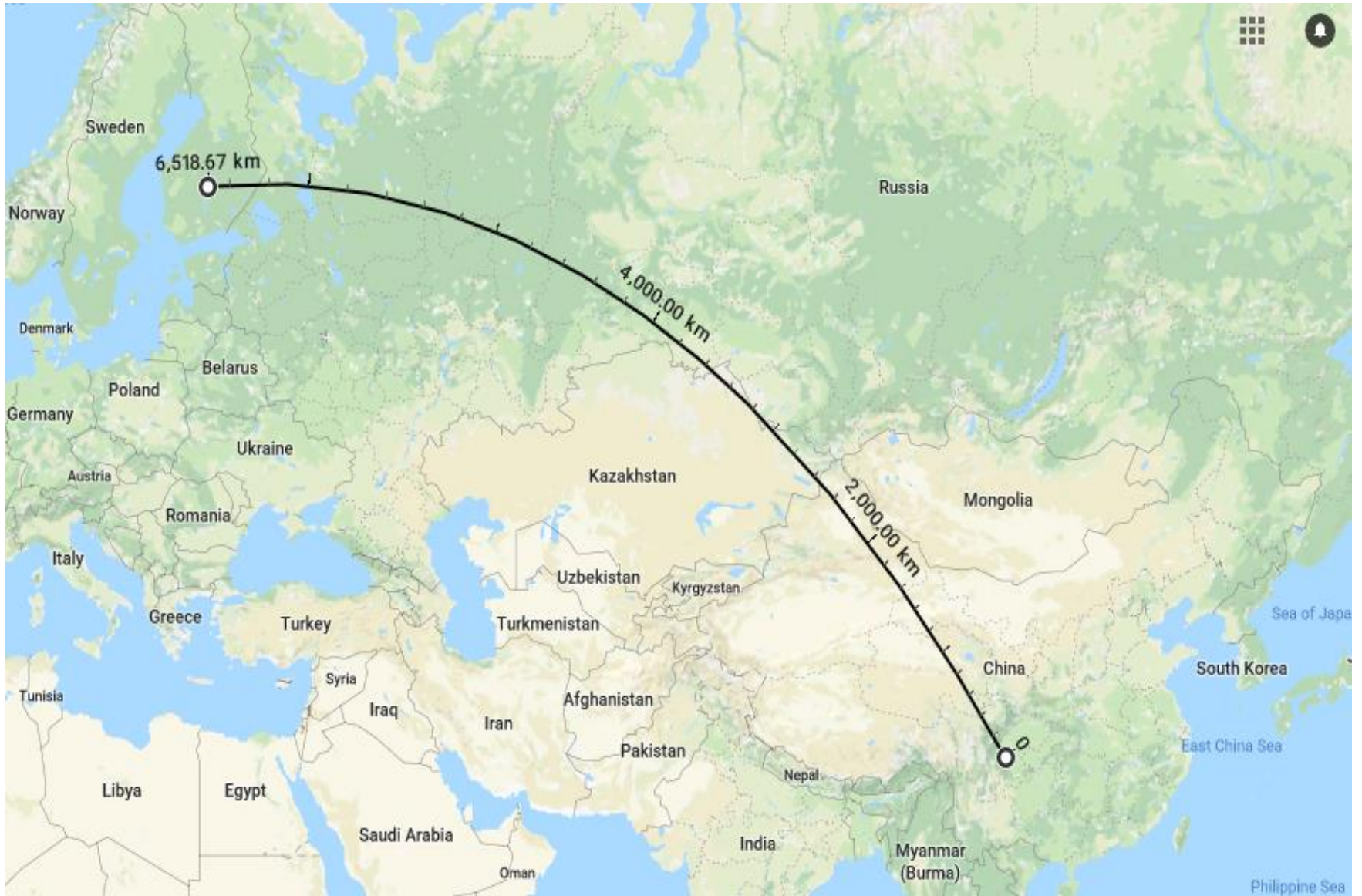
The Leshan Giant Buddha Scenic Area, together with Mount Emei Scenic Area has been listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1996.

Basic information

- 71-metre (233 ft) tall stone statue
- the largest and tallest stone Buddha statue in the world
- was built between 713 and 803 (during the Tang Dynasty) (around 90years)
- first started by a monk named Haitong to calm the turbulent waters that plagued the shipping vessels
- finance:donation from people and officials

How giant is it?

Head:width 10m,height 14.7m

Ear:length 7m

Eye:width 3.3m

Nose:length 5.6m

Mouth:width 3.3m

Neck:length 3.3m

Shoulder: width 24m

Middle finger:24m

Instep:11*9m
