SAVULAHTI SCHOOL AND DAYCARE CENTRE

- **Savulahti School and Day-care Centre** has opened on August 2019
- **Primary school:** 1-4 grades (2 classes of each grades: "A" and "B")
 - There are 177 students during this academic year 2024-2025
- **Day-care Centre:** 9 groups: 226 children, age between 1-6 yrs
- We have 57 staff members in Day-care Centre and 16 staff members at primary school
 - **Daycare Centre:** Teachers and Nurses of Early childhood education and care, Special education teachers and Special needs assistants
 - **School:** Class teachers and Special education teachers, Learning assistants

BASIC EDUCATION & EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION AND CARE

- Municipalities are responsible for arranging education for all 6 – 18 years olds living in a municipality.
 - **Pre-school education** starts one year before basic education at the age of 6
 - **Basic education** lasts for 10 years and it is for all youngsters between 7 and 18 years. Basic education is provided in a single structure system. It includes grades 1-9.
- Finnish **early childhood education and care (ECEC)** is based on an integrated approach to care, education and teaching, the so-called “educare” model, with particular emphasis on pedagogy.

TRANSITION POINTS AND CO-OPERATION ARE IMPORTANT

- **“The good start”**: All knowledge of the child’s skills and needs of support are important for his/her learning
 - we will transfer information forward to the other Day-care centre/School or we will receive info
 - Info will be transformed inside our centre:
 - From a child group to another group
 - From pre-school to primary school
 - From primary school to another school (from the 4th grade onwards)
- **School welfare group**: pre-schoolers included
- **Common operating culture**: e.g. against bullying

CO-OPERATION INSIDE OUR CENTRE

- Contact persons (teachers) between school and daycare
- Same timetable for students and pre-schoolers
- Co-operation and events with each others
 - collaboration between a named class and a child group
 - Theme days or events such as sports day, Autumn harvest day, “Christmas path” in a forest, Valentine’s Day, winter sport day, etc.
- Student committee: representatives of students and pre-schoolers
- SEN-teachers will visit the pre-school groups to get to know the children
- Teacher meetings, planning together
