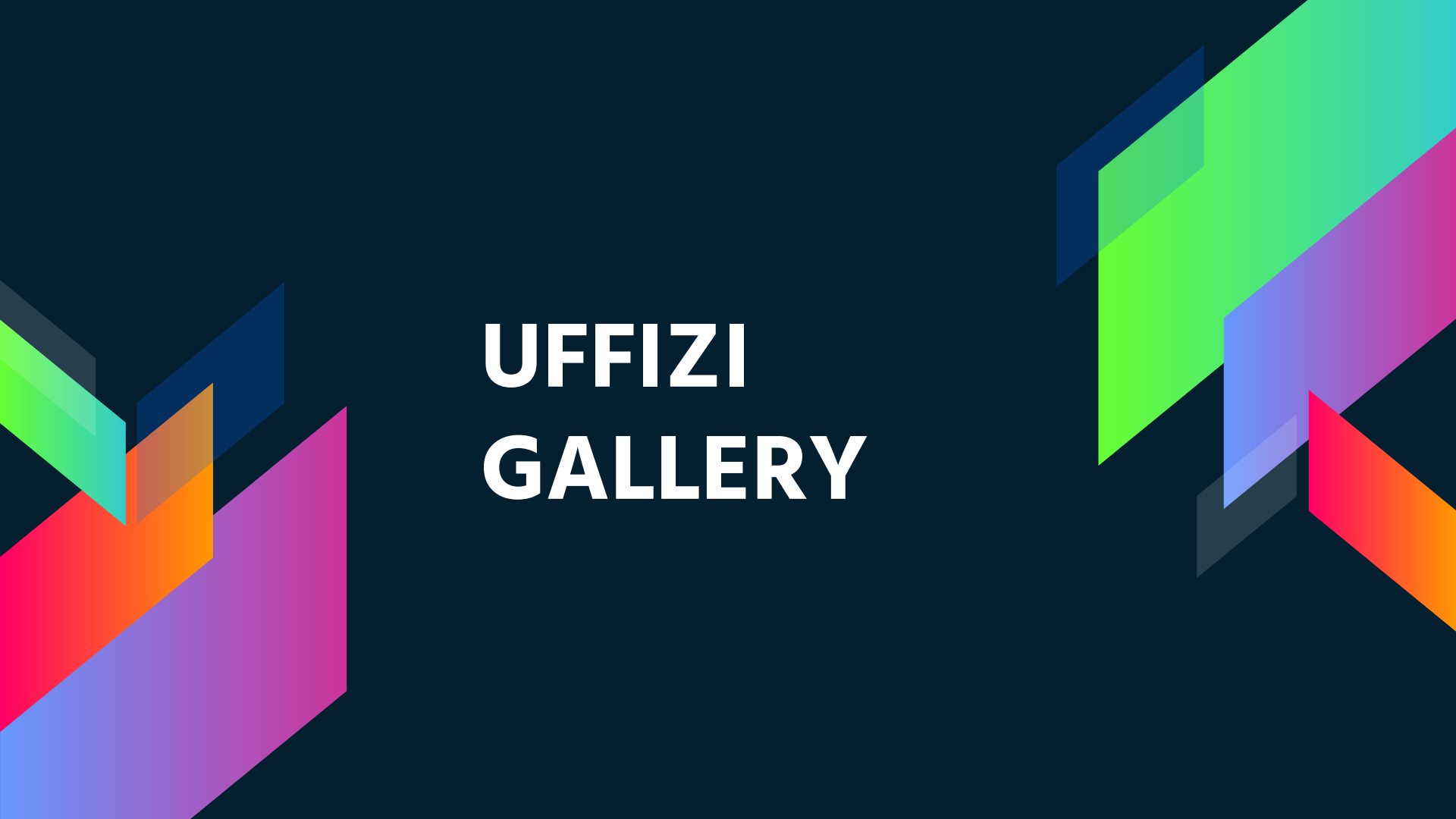

UFFIZI GALLERY



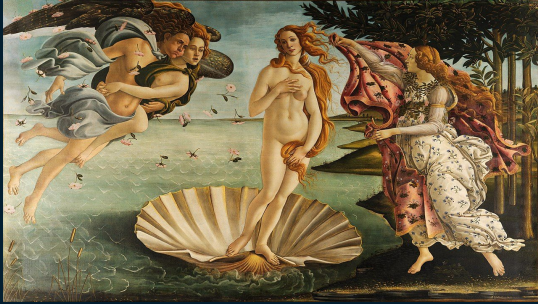
- ❖ Is the most famous museum in Florence, and one of the most famous and important museums in the world.
- ❖ It was built by Giorgio Vasari for Cosimo I de' Medici, to house the administrative and legal offices of Florence in 1580.

- ❖ The oldest art gallery in the world
- ❖ It was officially opened to the public in 1765
- ❖ Some of the artists are:
 - Michelangelo
 - Leonardo da Vinci
 - Sandro Botticelli
 - Tiziano
- ❖ One of the most protected work in the museum is Botticelli's *Birth of Venus*

The visit in Uffizi Gallery

- ❖ Gallery is open from Tuesday to Sunday, from 8.15 am to 6.50 pm
 - Closed: Mondays, New Year's Day, May 1st and Christmas Day
- ❖ Around 2 million visitors annually
 - The busiest months are very populous
- ❖ You can buy tickets online
- ❖ Photography is not allowed
- ❖ There is also a cafeteria in the Gallery
- ❖ Gallery is located adjacent to the Piazza della Signoria in the Historic Centre of Florence in the region of Tuscany, Italy.
