1. generous-spirited – “suurisydäminen”
2. Hard-hearted – kovasydäminen
3. Traditionally-minded – perinteinen
4. Weak-willed – “heikkotahtoinen” (lujaluonteisen vastakohta)
5. Tight-fisted - pihia
6. Self-centred – itsekeskeinen
7. Short-tempered – äkkipikainen
8. Thin-skinned – herkkänahkainen
9. Long-winded – pitkäveteinen
10. Cool-headed – järkevä, maltillinen (myös ‘level-headed’)
11. Dim-witted - tyhmä
12. Two-faced – kaksinaamainen
13. Absent-minded – hajamielinien
14. Ill-mannered – huonotapainen
15. Loud-mouthed – suurisuinen, kovaääninen

Adverbs for emphasis – huomaa sanajärjestys!

1. I can safely say – voin “rehellisesti” todeta (~ olen Varma)
2. I bitterly regret – kadun katkerasti
3. Strongly oppose – ovat vahvasti kännynköiden käyttöä vastaan
4. Firmly denies – kielää painokkaasti
5. Genuinely believes – uskoo todella ('aidosti')
6. I seriously feel – koen “vahvasti”
7. Strictly forbids – kielää ehdottomasti
8. Fully accept – hyväksymme täysin
9. I sincerely doubt – epäilen aidosti
10. I distinctly recall – muistan selvästi
