1) Nykyhetken aikamuodot:

preesens: I walk

perfekti: I have walked

futuuri: I will walk

2) Menneen ajan aikamuodot:

imperfekti: I walked

pluskvamperfekti: I had walked

konditionaali: I would walk

Älä sekoita kahden eri ryhmän aikamuotoja samoissa virkkeissä!

Epäsuora esitys noudattaa aikamuotoharmoniaa

Aikamuodot muuttuvat, kun jonkun sanoma alkuperäinen repliikki raportoidaan epäsuorasti.

Bill: "I hate grey winters!"

Bill said (that) he **hated** grey winters!

Päivi: "You will have a test tomorrow."

Päivi said that we/they would have a test the next day.

Päälause

Futuuri

We **will get** better seats

if-lause (as if, even if, even though) (futuurissa myös when, while, until)

if we **buy** the tickets in advance.

I konditionaali

We would get better seats

if we **bought** the tickets in advance.

II konditionaali

We would have got better seats

if we **had bought** the tickets in advance.
