

Craft school **Taituri** -creativity, joy and skills

Basic art education is leisure-time art education for children and young people provided at Community College of Kuopio.

The teaching is statutory and follows the national and the local school curricula.

Basic art education for children and young people, general curriculum The Taituri handicraft school is suitable for children and young people who enjoy learning new skills and want to get to know handicrafts in a variety of ways from the perspectives of expression, design and technology. By practicing together, you learn to plan your own work, craft skills and the use of materials and tools, as well as long-term work. Positive emotional experiences, the joy of learning and innovative activities promote learning and inspire the development of one's own skills. Experiences and interaction with the environment are essential in learning.

The teaching is divided into early age, basic and theme studies.

- Early childhood studies, children, 2-6 years old and adult together - common experiences and insights
- Early childhood studies, 5-6 years old - experimenting and wondering about the world of handicrafts
- Common studies, 6-14 years old - creative mastery of basic craft skills
- Theme studies, 13–19 years old - Your own strengths and skills to create something new

Groups will get together once a week from September till May.
