



HUMAN Rights Education: stand up for your rights

WHAT ARE HUMAN RIGHTS?

STEP 1- TEAM BUILDING: ICE-BREAKING ACTIVITY:

Each student writes his name on a piece of paper adhesive tape and attach it on his chest, then he introduces himself saying his name, two things about himself (one must be true and the other one must be a lie). Then he throws the tape to another student and he starts doing the same. Etc.

STEP 2

- BRIEF PRESENTATION OF THE TOPIC (10 minutes)
- WHAT IS THE UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS (10 minutes)
- Group work (3 people and 3-4 articles for each group). Students have to match articles of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and titles.

(PRINT THESE TITLES, CUT EACH TITLE WITH SHISSORS AND GIVE 3/4 STRIPS WITH ONE COPY OF THE DECLARATION TO EACH GROUP):
