A SCHOOL ECO-GARDEN

This is a **long term** project that we will be developing throughout the school year.

OBJECTIVES: WHY A SCHOOL ECO-GARDEN?

- Teaching students about **healthy eating** and the benefits of **sustainable living**.
- Giving students an opportunity to examine biodiversity in a practical way.
- Great for educating children about the benefits of conservation of our natural resources: harvesting water, and help to encourage an environmentally responsible attitude.
- Can provide students with hands-on learning opportunities while increasing environmental awareness.
- Children develop a sense of community.
- Instill lifelong appreciation for the natural world.
- An opportunity for teaching and learning outside.
- Promote a sense of responsible food choices (a more healthy diet)

WHAT'S AN ECO-GARDEN?

- Gardening Sustainably.
- Use Natural Fertilizers Rather Than Chemical.
- Conserve Water.
- Use Natural Methods Rather Than Chemical Pesticides To Combat Pests.

GARDENING TOOLS AND STORAGE: WHAT DO WE NEED? and WHERE ARE WE GOING TO STORE OUR TOOLS?

- Found a space under a staircase .
- Bought some tools and parents brought some other.











DESIGNING THE GARDEN : WHERE? / HOW?

Pupils examined the possible spaces on the school ground, they chose the location and decided to start with a small garden because it was November.

- Started taking off the leaves and cutting the grass.
- Then turned the soil. (dig double deep with a flat bladed spade and a bladed fork)





- Added compost and let it dry
- Tilled the big pieces of soil with a hoe and mixed it with the compost





Installed a fence....



• And our garden was ready to start planting.



• Students made a research about the plants that can be planted in autumn-winter and they started by planting seasonal, local foods



- Now we have to wait and take care of our garden.
- Meanwhile we will start with the next part of the project.
