



TIPS FOR A MORE SUSTAINABLE CHRISTMAS










- Ask for gifts you can share with your brothers and sisters.

- Buy your presents in Mutriku so you won't use your car.




- Don't buy so many gifts. You will get bored.

 Use energy-efficient lights to decorate our town.


 Use less lights to decorate our town.
