## A brief history of Thanksgiving

In December 1620 a ship called the Mayflower came to Plymouth, Massachusetts. Its passengers, known as the Pilgrims, came from England. It had been a long trip, the winter was tough and the Pilgrims didn't have much to eat. Only half of them survived the winter.

Native Americans called the Wampanoag lived in that area. They helped the Pilgrims to grow crops the following year. That fall the harvest was good and the Pilgrims had enough to eat. They wanted to celebrate. The Wampanoag weren't invited but they joined the feast anyway bringing even more food to the celebration. This was the very first Thanksgiving Day, celebrated in 1621.

In 1863 the US president, Abraham Lincoln, proclaimed a national day of Thanksgiving. In 1941 the Congress officially named the day when Thanksgiving is celebrated.
