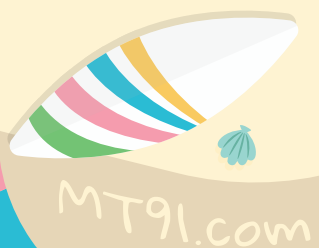

## Preparation

- Go together 3 to 5 players and find a dice
- Select a game piece each and cut them out
  - If you can't agree, the person whose birthday is closest to school start chooses first
- Place the game pieces on "START"
- Roll the dice, highest number starts, afterwards you take turns clockwise

## How to play

- The number you hit with the dice is the number of spaces you move forward
- The field you land on either has a task (off-white), summer break question (red), school question (blue) or a symbol (yellow)
  - If you don't complete the task or don't answer the question, you must move 2 spaces back
  - If you complete the task or answer the question, you must remain on the tile
- Whoever gets to the finish first wins
