

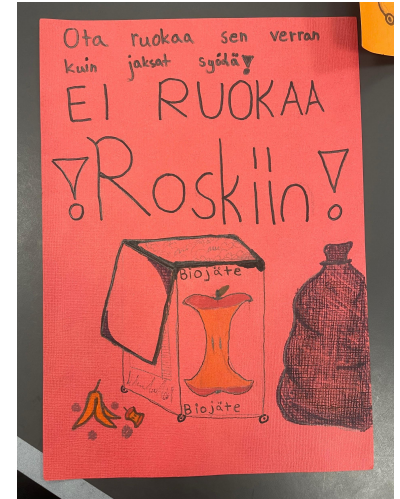

Our plan

Our plan is to get less food waste in our schools. We will do posters that says something about not throwing food into the trash and then people will start thinking the amount of food that they throw away in their daily life. Hopefully many people will start to think and we will have less food waste in our school.





Finland

In Finland our posters said “Ota ruokaa sen verran kuin jaksat syödä! Ei ruokaa roskiin!” which means that “Take as much food as you can eat! No food in the trash!”. We also did the posters on recess and we taped them around our school. When we were taping them in the cafeteria few kids (who are in first and second grade) started reading them as soon as we put them up. They were also super excited and they said that they would reduce food waste because they read it.





Germany

For the content of our posters „Reducing foodwaste“ we decided on short phrases to catch peoples attention while also informing about food waste and tips on how to reduce the waste. We used statistics to support our point for example: 1/4 of the food that is produced for schools gets thrown out.

For the design we chose bright colors with contrast and big letters.

Lebensmittelabfälle reduzieren

- 1.** Nimm zuerst kleinere Portionen. Du kannst jederzeit nachnehmen, wenn du noch Hunger hast.
- 2.** Nimm nur Essen mit, das du wirklich magst und das du auch essen willst.
- 3.** Die Reduzierung von Lebensmittelabfällen trägt zum Schutz der Umwelt und zur Schonung von Ressourcen bei.

- 48.860 Tonnen Lebensmittelabfälle entstehen pro Jahr in Schulen
- 92 % davon wären vermeidbar (45.040 Tonnen)
- Rund 1/4 der produzierten Schulspeisen wird weggeworfen
- 22 kg Speiseabfälle entstehen so pro Schüler*in und Jahr
