Instructions for Creating Presentations on Inclusion and Digitalization

General Guidelines for Presentations

- **Length of Presentation:** Aim for 5-7 minutes of speaking time. Remember: **SPEAKING IS NOT READING.**
 - **Slides:** Use 5-7 slides, making sure each slide covers one key idea.
 - **Visuals:** Use images, videos, or graphs to make your presentation interesting and engaging. You can also use infographics.
 - **Text:** Keep text on the slides short and clear. Focus on key points. Avoid large paragraphs.
 - **Style:** Use colors and fonts that are easy to read. Make sure the design is neat and professional.
