Oppitunnin kulku**Activity #1: Read Aloud Chapter 10**

- FINAL Chapter
- Peter comes home to discover that Dribble is missing
 - Fudge admits that he has eaten Dribble (just swallowed him, did not chew him)
- Fudge is given: castor oil, milk of magnesia and prune juice. Do the students know what these will do for Fudge??
- Peter is given a dog at the end of the book (he names it Turtle)

Activity #2: Trivia!

- Set up on the board, pre-made questions (see attached) and have the students divide into teams
- Team with highest score, wins

- Activating prior knowledge based on earlier reading, classroom discussions and journal questions through Trivia
- Encouraging active participation and positive oral usage through easy, understandable question and answers
- Overall understanding of Tales of a Fourth Grade Nothing
