


Finnish snipers during the Winter War


HISTORY

- Finland declared independence on the 6th of December 1917.
- Before its indepence, Finland was part of the kingdom of Sweden and, after Finland's land was conquered by it, Russia.
- The first book written in the Finnish language was the ABC Book by Mikael Agricola, the founder of the Finnish language.



Mikael Agricola translating the Bible to Finnish



HISTORICAL FIGURES

- Alexander I of Russia
 - The Russian Tsar who conquered Finland in 1809
- Kaarlo Juho Ståhlberg
 - Finland's first president
- Carl Gustaf Emil Mannerheim
 - Commander of the victorious side during the Finnish Civil War of 1918
- Tarja Kaarina Halonen
 - Finland's first female president

- Aleksis Kivi
 - Seven Brothers, 1870
- Johan Ludvig Runeberg
 - Our Land, Finnish national anthem, 1848
 - The Tales of Ensign Stål, 1848
- Elias Lönnrot
 - Kalevala, 1835, a collection of old folk stories that can be sang in its entirety. It is also the Finnish national epic

TRADITIONS

- Mid Summer
 - Often spent at a summer cottage
 - Sauna and swimming
 - A (excessively) large fire pit is lit
- Independence Day
 - All lights are turned off with the exception of two candles, which are lit on a window sill
 - Families get together to watch The Unknown Soldier, a Finnish war film depicting a group of Finnish soldiers in 1941 in the Continuation War against the Soviet Union
