

PLAY OF LATANE, DARLEY & MCGUIRE 1968 STUDY: “INTERCOM STUDY”

Read pages 411–412 and use external sources if needed. As a group, create a replication of **Latane, Darley & McGuire (1968)** “*intercom study*” in form of a play. The play should contain the following information:

- What were the *aim, procedure* and *results* of the study?
- What kind of *conclusions* can be deduced from the results?
- What kind of *factors affecting bystanderism* did the study reveal? (Page 413)
- If possible, try to incorporate elements of MAGEC and GRENADE analysis into your play
 - **MAGEC: Methods? Alternative explanation AND Application? Gender? Ethics? Culture?**
 - **GRENADE: Gender? Reductionism vs. holism? Ethics? Nature vs. nurture? Approach? Determinism vs. free will? Ethnocentrism?**

Compile a script for the play and prepare to present it to the other group.

In addition to the actual play, produce a brief and effective summary of the study that you can upload to OneNote.

Prepare to evaluate your own play and the other group’s play. How well did the play bring forth the essential features of the study? How well did you perform?
