

News Summary

- Find a recent news story on a topic that interests you.
- Follow or backtrack the story for a week using at least three different sources/texts/news reports to get material for your summary.
- At least one of the sources should be an audio/video report. Name the sources in your summary.

Include the following content in your summary

- What happened?
- Who were involved?
- Where?
- When?
- Why?
- Why is this news?
- How does this news affect you/Finland?
- Why did you choose this topic?
- What are the reasons for this news?
- What are the consequences of this news?
- What are the consequences of this news?
- Were there any differences in how the topic was covered in the sources you used?

- Present your report to the group.
- Ask them to talk about 2 -3 follow-up questions on the topic of your piece of news.
- Keep the follow-up questions simple – remember that the group hasn't been following the news topic as intensively as you.
- Length of your report: ca. 5 minutes + group discussion
