Language

- 1. Can the speaker be understood without difficulty? If not, why?
- 2. Is the language correct and stylistically good? If not why?
- 3. Is the pronunciation clear and understandable?

Structure

- 4. Does the presentation seem well prepared? If not, why?
- 5. Is the beginning attention-grabbing? Does the speaker mark the ending of the presentation clearly?
- 6. Is the structure of the presentation (intro, various topics, ending) clear?
- 7. Does the speaker use any indicators in his/her speech that show the structure of the presentation to the audience (e.g. "first I will tell you about....")
- 8. Does the speaker emphasise the main points clearly?
- 9. Is the content interesting?
- 10. Does the presentation last as long as it is supposed?

Presentation

- 11. Is the body language appropriate for the situation? If not, why?
- 12. Is the voice loud enough?
- 13. Is the speed ok? If not why?
- 14. Does the presenter use his/her notes in a way that it do not disturb the contact with the audience?

 If not why? Does the speaker rather speak than read?
- 15. Is the presenter enthusiastic about his/her own topic?
- 16. Does the presenter offer the audience a chance to ask questions after the presentation?
- 17. The overall impression? Could this kind of presentation be given in a real situation?
