**2) Patented** in the mid-1950s, the first collapsible buggy was also English, Saffron Walden-born Owen Maclaren **3) having previously designed** the undercarriage for the Supermarine Spitfire.

Bicycles are faster, lighter, use sexier materials and are 4) consequently hugely more expensive than ever before, but the arrangement of a diamond frame and two similar-sized wheels really hasn't changed much since 1885.

John Kemp Starley introduced the concept with his Rover safety cycle, a design which proved so influential that in Poland a bike is still referred **5) to** as a 'rower'.
