


 Finnish health-care system is funded with taxes and its free of charge to all citizens under 18 y.o.

Kansaneläkelaitos (Kela)

- Kela = The Social Insurance Institution
- Finnish government agency in charge of settling benefits under national social security programs

Every Finnish citizen has a right to a <u>free</u>

Drugs from pharmacy

- In Finland only pharmacies can sell drugs
