Faith heals?

Is our dependence 1 medicine necessary? Scientists increasingly believe that the patient's own strong belief 2 healing can often work just as effectively as drugs. This is partly due to the placebo effect, the power of our bodies to find a cure 3 any disease and self-heal. When patients hear they are getting pain relief, for instance, their confidence 4 the pain vanishing soon causes an increase 5 the release of the neurotransmitter dopamine in the brain. Research 6 the placebo effect even suggests that many drugs may only be boosters to the placebo effect. However, there is no shortage 7 problems with harnessing placebos for mainstream use. If we accept that many drugs mostly work on sham, then will we lose faith 8 medicine? Our expectations will plunge, and with them the placebo effect. For it to work, we may have to forget that, as a matter of fact, much of the influence of drugs 9 our bodies involves faith-healing. In your view, has any of this made an impression 10 you so far?

Run to learn
