


Give a overall rating to the whole project on scale 1-10




Rate the program in Portugal in 2016 on scale 1-10




Rate the program in Finland in 2017 on scale 1-10










### Did you consider starting a company of your own before the project?




### Do you consider starting a company of your own now, after the project?




### Did you consider working in other European country before the project?




# Do you consider working in other European country now, after the project?




#### Did you learn something about wind power during the project?




# Did you learn something about travelling to an other country during the project?




# Did you learn something about Finnish/Portuguese culture during the project?




### Did you learn more about using ITC (computers) during the project?




#### Did your skills of English language develop during the project?
