“Building Bridges - opportunities for young Europeans”
22.-26.05.2017, Europahaus in Aurich

Europahaus in Aurich will organise a training course for young people, from 18 years old onwards, who have taken part in youth meetings in the past and who would be interested to work as assistant leaders in future projects.

We are aiming to offer young people the possibility to continue being active on a European level and getting to know the Erasmus+ program from a different perspective.

We are searching for young adults, open to supporting us in the future projects, who are interested in taking a little more responsibility in the projects and who would like to influence the future of Europe.

During the project we will talk about Erasmus+ in general. We will have look at what Europe means for us and why it is valuable to take part in youth meetings.
