THE SCHOOL RULES AT CYGNAEUS

- 1. I follow the school timetable.
 - I go to recess quickly
 - I come inside from recess as soon as the bell rings
 - In the mornings I only come inside once the bell has rung
- 2. I take care of my school work.
- 3. I take care of the school environment and equipment
 - I am responsible for any damages that I've caused on purpose.
- 4. My phone and smart devices stay in my backpack during the school day
 - I can only use my phone with a teacher's permission.
- 5. Recess:
 - I will not throw snowballs or stones.
 - I will not leave the school grounds without permission.
 - I will not hang around the bike racks.
 - I follow the agreed game turns and recess practices. See separate instructions
- 6. I will not bully anyone.
 - I treat all students and adults at school with respect.
- 7. I will exercise good table manners.
- 8. Dangerous objects and substances
 - I won't bring any dangerous objects or substances to school (knives, firecrackers, laser pointers, alcohol or tobacco)

In the event that I don't follow the school rules, I understand that there will be consequences.

According to the Laws of Basic Education, consequences or punishments for rule breaking offences may be: having to clean, an educational disciplinary discussion, detention, barring a pupil from participating in a class, making a pupil do undone homework assignments, a written warning or a suspension from school.

I also understand that a teacher or the headmaster can go through my belongings, and that she/he can confiscate any offending items, dangerous objects or substances.

Any instances of bullying, bad behaviour or violence at school, or on the way to
school and back, will be reported to the families of those involved.

I also understand that all types of cyberbullying, online or through phones and social
media, is strictly forbidden. Furthermore, I understand that participating in this kind of
action is a punishable offence.
