

Yippee! 6 Chapters 10 to 12: working at your own pace 2022

- ★ Everyone **studies in pairs**. The teacher will tell you who you work with.
- ★ You have **9 lessons + homework (about 3 hours/chapter)** to at your use.
- ★ **Plan** your work well and do enough **homework**. For example, 1st lesson Start, 2nd lesson words for the chapter, 3rd lesson grammar.
- ★ At school, **do all the tasks you need to do with a friend** before moving on to written tasks.
- ★ Tick (✓) each task in your handout after you have **done and checked** them.
- ★ If something about the tasks or grammar is puzzling you, **ask for help**.
- ★ We **start and end** each lesson in the classroom. If necessary, you can work outside the classroom, but only after asking for a permission. *Working elsewhere must not disturb anyone else.*
- ★ **Phones and iPads** can be used while working, but only after asking for a permission. If the phones and iPads are not being used as they should be, **they're not allowed**.
- ★ If you or your friend are **away from school**, do written tasks and **tell each other** what you have done during the lessons.
- ★ Tasks marked with a **star are extra**. Only do them *after you have done all the tasks you need to do*.
- ★ *After finishing all the tasks on one hand out, **show** them and the handout to the teacher.*
